## Second Sunday of Easter - Year C 3rd April 2016

From the Pastor's Desk

Divine Mercy Sunday (Second Sunday of Easter): Mercy Upon Mercy Upon Mercy: John 20: 19-31.

Believe to Continue the Mission of Christ.

One of the most moving stories of mercy came to us on October 6, 2006, when an armed man entered an Amish schoolhouse in Nickle Mines, Pennsylvania, USA. The man chased out the little boys and lined up ten little girls in front of the blackboard. He shot all of them and killed himself. Five of these girls died. After the medics and police left, the families of the fallen carried their slain children home. They sat for a time and mourned their beloved children. After a while they walked to the home of the man who killed their children. They told the widow of the man that they forgave him and consoled her for the loss of her spouse. They buried their anger before they buried their children! What a great story to speak of on God's mercy Sunday! It is because Jesus is the face of God's mercy that we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. St Faustina of Poland, who was canonized a saint on April 30th, 2000, is the well-known apostle of Divine Mercy

The readings for this Sunday are about mercy, trust and the forgiveness of sins. The first reading explains how the risen Lord continued to show his Divine Mercy to the sick through the healing, and proclaim it to others through preaching of the apostles in the early church. The faith/belief of the apostles enabled and gave them the energy to minister to the people through 'signs and wonders' from the Lord. The second one from the book of Revelation is to comfort and to bolster the Faith of the persecuted Christians by reassuring them of the presence of the merciful Lord in their sufferings. In today's Gospel, we are strongly reminded of the mercy of God - the power to forgive sins to his apostles - whose sins you forgive are forgiven them (Jn 20:23). ABC of Mercy: A for ask for God's Mercy, for God wants us to approach Him in faith and prayer so that God's mercy be poured out upon us and upon the whole world. B for be merciful, for God wants us to receive his mercy and let it flow from the hearts through our ideas words and deeds to others. C for our total trust in Jesus, the face of Divine Mercy, the more we trust in Jesus the more become merciful people on earth.


