Feast of Saints Peter & Paul 3rd July 2016

From the Pastor's Desk

Acts 12:1-12; Timothy 4; 6-8, 17-18; Matthew 16:13-19:

Believe that Jesus is the Christ and proclaim this Faith.

The figures of Peter and Paul tower over the life of the early church and they are venerated together as the feast is celebrated from the very beginning of the tradition. Peter is the first pope and the present pope Francis is his successor and thus the apostolic tradition from Peter to the present pope is a great way that the church is guided by the Spirit of Christ. Paul is called by the Risen Lord and his mission was to be a great missionary to the Gentiles, thus opening the new way of Christ to be a light to the nations. Both died as martyrs in Rome under the persecution of Nero between 64 and 67. This preeminent feast day of the city of Rome has been celebrated on the date June 29 since the mid-third century. Their feast day is given importance in the liturgical tradition and The Preface for their feast condenses their heritage in this way:

For by your guidance /The blessed apostles Peter and Paul bring us joy. Peter, foremost in confessing the Faith/ Paul, its outstanding preacher.

For us, St Peter's parish community, it is *our parish feast and our Patron saint's day*. A day to appreciate the blessings we have been given and the Faith we have been celebrating as a community. Remember that we had our 40th anniversary two years ago and hence past 42 years we had been guided by the Holy Spirit and the patronage and intercession of Saint Peter have been a great light in our parish and its manifold mission. Though the feast falls on June 29th every year, we celebrate it on a weekend to make it a parish feast. For us, Simon Peter's profession of faith in Jesus as "The Christ, the Son of the living God" becomes the saving mission and in response Jesus affirms and commissions Peter "You are Peter and on this rock I will build my Church" become the central event of our faith story. And the focus is on Peter's Faith, his courage, and his foundational role in the church, and on our own answer to Jesus' question, "Who do you say I am?"

As we celebrate the Feast of these great saints Peter and Paul, we commission all our ministries and all the ministers who share their faith to make our parish life vital and full of work for Christ. While I thank all the ministers, I do extend the invitation to new volunteers to be active in the ministry of our parish life. May the Christ the Risen Lord bless our home, the St Peter's Parish and all of us its members.
