## The Financial Report of St Peter's, Rochedale

Parish financial affairs are the responsibility of and managed by the Parish Priest. The Parish Priest has appointed a Parish Finance Council to assist him with these aspects. This report will cover the following parts: 1. Governance; 2 Income & Expenditure; 3. Asset Requirements (future expenses). In general, our financial situation is good but needs to be improved for continuing development.

Governance: All financial aspects are conducted in accordance with Archdiocesan policies. Bookkeeping is now online with the Archdiocesan office and is audited annually. The 2018 Budget has been completed and is reviewed monthly against actual expenditure. Expenses are reviewed to ensure we utilise our resources as efficiently & effectively as possible. To this end, we are currently upgrading the computers in the Parish Office. A review of assets is about to be undertaken for both security and Insurance purposes.

**Income & Expenditure:** Expenses are well managed and Credit must be given to Julie, our Parish secretary, and Diane Land, our volunteer bookkeeper, and our wonderful band of parishioners who VOLUNTEER their time in many ways.

Income—The cornerstone of our income is our WEEKLY GIVING – which unfortunately is not meeting our expenditure requirements and has in fact been steadily declining over the past 5+ years.

To this end our Planned Giving Committee has been addressing you about both

- 1. increasing our GIVINGS where possible as well as
- 2. more cost-effective ways of giving Bank Direct transfer/Direct credit/debit facilities which save staff time thus effectively reducing costs

Excluding employment, our largest expenditure items are fixed type costs – Electricity, Rates, Insurance – you all understand how much these have increased over the past 5+ years – it is simply necessary that we look to keep up with these costs.

**Assets:** \$10 000 has just been expended on a sewerage line in the carpark as the tree roots had penetrated the old pipes causing overflows across the entrance & exit to the carpark – pipes have been relined – we have a 20 year guarantee and there was no disruption to Church or School access.

General maintenance, as required, has been ongoing however we have a few priority items which will require drawing on our capital reserve, such as: 1. lighting upgrade (safety); 2. replacing some guttering and associated water damage (non insurance); 3. replace the gravel pathway between front entrance and the church (safety); 4. hand rails to entrance of carpark (safety).

There are other items which we are investigating and considering which relate to safety and security. There are also items we are looking at to reduce future costs e.g. electricity costs and as well as items many Parishioners are suggesting/ requesting e.g. cushioning of kneelers/ seats, air-conditioning. Although we have adequate funds and seek grants to avoid using reserves where possible, the most important thing we need to ensure is that we cover our normal running costs from our GIVINGS hence (continued on page 3)






