Pastor's Note:

Isaiah 11:1-10; Romans 15:4-9; Matthew 3:1-12; Choose Life and Love

In the first reading Prophet Isaiah presents Zion (city of Jerusalem) as the centre of the peaceful cosmos. This peace is seen on two levels: the first is on the level of the future king's ('a shoot') character and rule. He will be filled with the Spirit of the Lord and will have the gifts required to judge fairly ad not by mere appearances. The poor and the meek will be protected completely; the ruthless and the wicked will be judged with integrity and fairness. The second level is seen in the peaceful cosmos/world where humans, animals and the rest of nature will live in harmony without the need to destroy each other. A new vision for our troubled, disturbed, torn and broken world.

John the Baptist was the last in a long line of prophets who foretold the coming of the Messiah. He prepared the way for the One who is to come by alerting God's people to the Messiah's impending arrival and by challenging them to change their lives by repenting for their sins. A radical abandonment of sinful living was required because God was going to communicate with his people directly through his son Jesus the Messiah. John's ministry focused on preaching conversion and proclaiming forgiveness of sin. Repentance is a fundamental change of heart or attitude, which results in leaving sin behind and embracing God's freely shared life and love. Such change is only possible with the gift of God's grace. The time of repentance, he said, is now, not in the future. Repentance through prayer, fasting and charitable works, leads to conversion, and conversion is an important aspect of our preparation if we are to meet Christ when he comes.

Leonardo a Vinci painted the fresco (wall painting), the Last Supper, in Santa Maria delle Grazie church in Milan in three years (1495-1498). It is said that when he started painting The Last Supper, he had an enemy who was a fellow-painter. He despised him and had conflict with this man. When he painted Judas Iscariot at the table with Jesus, he used the face of this enemy artist so that it would be present for ages as the face of the man who betrayed Jesus. As he worked on the faces of other apostles, he tried to paint the face of Jesus, but he couldn't make any progress. Vinci felt frustrated and confused. In time, he realized what was wrong. His hatred for the other painter was holding him back from finishing the face of Jesus. Only after making peace with this fellow-painter, and repainting the face of Judas as described in the gospels, he could paint and finish the face of Jesus and complete the masterpiece. Be at peace with your fellow humans and that is the way to prepare for the Lord's coming.


