Proclaim 2018 - Leadership

This year's Proclaim 2018 National Catholic Conference highlighted five main topics as part of the conference: Leadership, Young People, Belonging, Culture Change and Evangelisation. As one of the delegates that represented St Peter's at Proclaim 2018, for this week's newsletter I will be sharing my thoughts on what I have learnt about Leadership from Proclaim 2018.

Authority. Passion. Tenderness. Commitment. Courage. Mission. Action. There are many other words that describe the qualities of a leader, but these were the few that spoke the most to me from the Proclaim 2018 conference. A leader is usually an individual in a position of authority. In our Catholic Church, the highest of all being Pope Francis our Pope, followed by the Cardinals, Archbishops, Bishops, and Parish Priests. At every level they are all our leaders. They have the authority to guide us in faith as Jesus did. If the parishioners are the sheep, then they are our shepherds, Passion is required to be a leader. Nobody can be a leader just for the sake of it. It has to come from within the person. The drive, the will to act and represent. The desire to excel and achieve results, outcomes, targets and goals. As for the virtue of tenderness, Pope Francis is an excellent example of a tender leader. So was Mother Teresa and St Mary MacKillop. Jesus Himself, at the Last Supper, washed the feet of His disciples, an act of love and tenderness.

A leader should be committed to see his/her tasks through. The realisation that other people are depending on the leader further emphasises the need for the individual to have commitment to their role as a leader. It takes great courage to be a leader. It requires a person to step out of their comfort zone to take up certain responsibilities, to serve others and not just to be served. That is what Jesus's Mission is.

Matthew 28:19-20 'Go therefore, and make disciples from all nations. Baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teach them to fulfil all that I have commanded you. I am with you always until the end of this world.' As followers of Christ, Jesus has given his command asking us to be leaders, to spread His good news to the world. Jesus wants us to take action. As one of the speakers at the Proclaim 2018 conference Shane Dwyer aptly puts it: 'Get out of the boat'. As Christians, we are urged not to sit idly and focus on ourselves, but to take up the challenge that Jesus has given us. We can all lead in our faith through our actions, words and deeds.

We should ask ourselves, how can we as Christians, better serve our community? What can we, to the best of our abilities, do to help? Why should we help?

I would like to encourage all parishioners at St Peter's to be leaders in their Catholic faith. Join a ministry, volunteer in activities and get involved!

<u>Cherish Life:</u> As you would have seen in the news on Monday 16 July, the State Government announced it will adopt the Queensland Law Reform Commission's recommended **abortion decriminalisation bill**, which would **legalise even late-term abortion and sex-selection abortion**. The Attorney-General said the bill would be referred to the Health Committee on 21st August, then be voted on in Parliament in the week commencing 16th October. The Termination of Pregnancy Bill would allow abortion to birth, effectively for any reason. It is very important that we all contact our Members of Qld Parliament and let them know how strongly we oppose this Bill before 16th October.
