Looking back at 2017

Time flies. In the blink of an eye, New Year's Day of 2018 has passed over one week ago. Before New Year's Day, everyone was busy. Our hearts were difficult to settle for a review and reflection of 2017. Now I guess it's a good time for us to do it.

Everything went well in 2017 in our Parish. As always, our weekend liturgy and sacramental programs have achieved great success. Apart from that, there were still many things that happened in 2017 for which we should thank God. Below is a simple list.

- At the end of February, we farewelled Fr Jacob, who had served our Parish as Parish Priest for about 3 years, having made great contributions to the development of our Parish. We thank him for his hard work.
- In March we recruited and formed the Mass Co-ordinators Ministry Group.
 These Ministers make sure everything is ready for Mass to begin.
- On 12/05, my Installation Mass was successfully celebrated. Archbishop Mark was the chief celebrant and 13 priests and 2 deacons concelebrated. In addition to our own parishioners, many attendees were from my previous parishes and the Chinese Catholic Community. The liturgy was solemn and prayerful.
- At the end of May, we made some changes to Friday morning Mass.
 During the school terms, the Mass is now led by students. They read and
 serve during the Mass. Also we invited the school to prepare music and
 PowerPoint for the Mass. We try to get the students involved in Mass as
 much as possible. By this, we hope they can attend the Mass more
 actively and effectively.
- In June, our Parish formed a group of people to support altar serving and recruited more than ten new altar servers. After that, many training sessions and fellowship activities were successfully held.
- In August, we changed the time of taking up collections. Now we take up
 the first collection immediately after the homily and the second one at the
 offertory. After the homily, we can have more time to reflect with the background music while taking up the collection. Also those who need to leave
 immediately after receiving Communion can have a chance to contribute.
- On 7/10, our Parish dance dinner was happily held at the Glen Hotel. About 80 people plus VIPs attended. It was wonderful and everyone had a great time. Also we fundraised over one thousand dollars for security lights. However, later we were told that we could apply for a government grant for this purpose. The application is now in process.
- From October to November, we held our Parish Census.
- In the beginning of November, the transition to the new Parish Pastoral Council was smoothly made.
- In the middle of November, we had a successful Planned Giving Commitment Weekend. We are still working on it and a report will be given later.

In summary, with God's grace, our Parish had a smooth and successful year of 2017. While thanking God, I, on behalf of our Parish, would like to thank all those who supported our Parish and made the development of our Parish in 2017 possible. Let us work hard in 2018 and continue to build up our spiritual family of St Peter's, Rochedale.

Monday 8th January is the feast day of The Baptism of the Lord

Drawing from the Eastern tradition of Epiphany, the West has remembered the baptism of the Lord on the octave of the Epiphany since the eighth century. Formally introduced into the Roman calendar in 1960 on the Sunday after the Epiphany, it now concludes the Christmas season. Commemorates the revelation of Jesus as God's beloved Son, the Christ, anointed by the Spirit.

The Epiphany of the Lord

The earliest Christmas feast, originating in the East in the third century and passing to the West in the fourth century. Celebrates the divine "manifestation" or "coming". In the East it commemorates the baptism of the Lord and in the West the visit of the Magi. The mystery of the incarnation is now revealed to everyone in the world, represented by these wise men from foreign lands.

<u>Planned Giving Commitment:</u> Remember that there are several ways you can contribute to our Planned Giving Program to keep our parish functioning fully


