From the Pastor's Desk

The Ascension of the Lord: Luke 24:46-53.

Are You an Active Witness to the Risen Lord?

Luke tells in the Acts of the Apostles(1:3) that Jesus was seen in his risen form for forty days. And after those forty days, Jesus was no more seen in his risen body. The feast of today marks this stage of transition in the story of incarnation and resurrection - that Jesus is not visible in his earthly body as such. And Mark describes this 'withdrawal' of Jesus in terms of "being taken up into heaven (Mark 16:19). Hence, the 'Ascension of the Lord! However, with our modern familiarity with rocket science, we shouldn't be led to think of the feast in terms of a count down and then Jesus being shot up to heaven! So let me be very precise in my reflection of the feast. We are his people who have our eyes fixed on heaven but at the same time have our feet firm on the ground.

There is a funny story about a man, who when he was in his twenties, walking along a city street, had found a hundred dollar bill. Since then, that day the man decided to always look down expectantly as he walked on the street. By the time he reached seventy, he had gathered quite a lot of stuff: he had found hundreds of wallets with credit cards and IDs; the money he had collected would have amounted to thousands of dollars. If he had collected pins and bottle tops, they would have filled truck loads. If in our times he would have picked up some mobile phones and at least some i-pods and i-phones! But above all, he ended up having a hunch-back!

The feast today invites us to look up. To have our eyes fixed on heaven. Luke tells, "As he blessed them, he withdrew from them and was carried up to heaven" (24:51). He goes on to add in the Acts of the Apostles, as we heard in the first reading, "As he said this, he was lifted up while they looked on, and a cloud took him from their sight." Now we are told that this is the meaning of the whole story: receive the spirit of the master and be empowered by the same Spirit to continue his mission on earth. After the parting of Jesus, Luke tells us that the disciples 'went back to Jerusalem full of joy(24:52). Then, have feet firm on the earth: looking up to heaven is to get power from on high to be expressed and executed in their/our commitment to transforming the world with the expectant hope of his second coming in glory.


