Episcopal Council Pastoral Visit to Our Deanery

In June this year, I found myself copied in an email from Archbishop Mark Coleridge to Fr John Conway, Dean of our deanery, informing us about a special visit of the Episcopal Council to the parishes of the Logan Deanery on a listening tour in early September. Last year, the same visit was paid to South Coast and South Country Deanery. The Archbishop said that the two visits have assisted the Episcopal Council greatly in their mission of planning for the future. I believe that this visit will be a great opportunity for the parish and school leadership team to communicate with the Episcopal Council. By doing this, the Archdiocese and the parishes may have a better and deeper understanding of each other. Hopefully this will enable considerable progress in evangelization to be made on both the levels of the parish and the Archdiocese.

Members of the Episcopal Council include the archbishop, auxiliary bishop, vicar general, vicar for clergy, director of clergy life & ministry and assisted by two lay persons. This visit is called a listening tour. The Episcopal Council would like to listen to the voice of every parish. On 5th and 6th September, in each parish, the parish priest, associate pastor, parish secretary, the chairpersons of parish pastoral council and parish finance council, along with the principal and APRE of the school will respectively have a meeting with one member of the Episcopal Council. On Saturday 7th September, a forum including the key stakeholders will take place at St Joseph's Memorial Primary School Hall, Beenleigh Parish.

The Episcopal Council has prepared some questions for us to consider and address in the interviews. Of course, as the members of the parish leadership team, we will have our answers to the questions. I have also invited the members of our Parish Pastoral Council and Parish Finance Council to have their answers to these questions. I would like to list the questions here and invite each of you to have your answers, too. You are welcome to write down your answers and place them into the St Peter's Post Box, located at the back of the church near the main entrance.

The questions are as follows:

- 1. What do you see as the three successful attributes of your parish?
- 2. What do you see as the three biggest challenges in your parish?
- 3. If you had unlimited resources, what would you like to see happen in the parish in the next 10-20 years?
- 4. In regard to lay leadership, how might lay leadership play a role in sustaining the parish into the future in collaboration with the priest?
- 5. If you were the Archbishop of Brisbane, what decisions would you make in relation to your parish and how the Deanery is managed?
- 6. Do you have any further comments for the consideration of the Episcopal Council?

My dear friends, when you read this reflection, the visit will have finished. However, you can still have your contribution and we will have our ways to include them into our future parish plans. If necessary and relevant, we also will convey your opinions and suggestions to the Episcopal Council. Please continue to pray for and contribute to the building of our Church.

2019 Annual Catholic Campaign.
Our Church, Our Mission, Our Community

Jesus says that the way of true liberation is renunciation, even of what we seem to depend upon – family, possessions, even our own life. Our true security is found in sharing the sacrifice of the Cross. This is strange: loss turns out to be gain and death turns out to be life. That's the logic of God that underlies his plan.

The Annual Catholic Campaign takes its place within that logic and that plan. Each year the Campaign invites the Catholic community to help in accomplishing God's plan. Supporting the ministries through the Annual Catholic Campaign involves renunciation, even sacrifice. But I ask you to make a calm and reasonable assessment of what you can give and to do so in recognition of where your true security lies, what your life really depends upon. What is also clear is that your generosity will be the answer to someone's prayer, which is again the way God wants it to be.

The Annual Catholic Campaign was intended to reduce multiple Sunday appeals to a single appeal. But the intention behind it goes far beyond that. In the end, the intention is to call the Catholic people of the Archdiocese into the unfolding plan of God – not just to help the needy but to bring to birth a new ordering of human relationships, a society where brothers and sisters can embrace each other in the compassion of God. So I urge you to say yes to that.

Faith Matters! Prayer Is ...Not Difficult.
Sometimes as much as we want to pray, we find ourselves putting it off with thoughts and feelings such as, "It's too hard!", or "I don't know what to say!" or "Others do it better than me!". Again the Saints come to our rescue with their wisdom learnt on their own faith journeys.

The words of the Spanish Priest, St Josemaria Escriva (1902 – 1975) help us to start. "You don't know how to pray? Put yourself in the presence of God, and as soon as you have said, 'Lord, I don't know how to pray!" you can be sure you have already begun."

While the words of the French Priest, St John Vianney (1786 – 1859) help us with the words. "We do not have to talk very much in order to pray well. We know that God is there in His holy tabernacle; let us open our hearts to Him; let us rejoice in His Presence: This is the best prayer." Try being both intentional and relaxed about praying this week.
