## A Trip of Love

I had to go back to China on 9th August due to the passing of my Mum. There were many difficulties on the way, however, I arrived home safely. Looking back now, many things were amazing. I believe if God had not cared about me all the way, if God had not sent those loving people to help me, I would not have been able to get back to China so smoothly. Now I'm back to Rochedale, my beloved parish, being with you, my beloved parishioners. Thank God so much! I would like to share with you some things that happened on the way.

When I was told that Mum was dying, I felt completely at a loss. But there were many important things that I had to deal with, such as informing the Archdiocese and purchasing the tickets etc. With God's help, these were done quite easily. All those whom I contacted were very patient and did their best to help me. All of them consoled me, saying, "Don't worry about anything here. We will take care of everything." That night, I got the news that Mum had passed. I felt very sad. Next morning, I told the news to some people. In a very short time, I received condolences from many people, among them were Monsignor Peter Meneely VG, Fr Dan Ryan and Archbishop Mark Coleridge. After my arrival at the airport, I received a call from one parishioner, saying that she and her husband worried that I did not have enough money so they came to the presbytery, bringing me some cash! Very kind!

I transferred planes at Guangzhou to Wuhan, my capital city. I had to use this period of time to withdraw some Chinese currency. Carelessly, I lost the bank card with which I was withdrawing some cash. At that time, I really didn't know what to do. It was then when I heard someone shouting, "Who has lost a bank card?" Then I got the card back. That gentleman worked at the airport. He found the card on a table. If he had not tried to return the card to its owner, I would possibly lose some money and would not be able to withdraw any cash before I got home. I thank him a lot.

The scheduled flight from Guangzhou to Wuhan was at 9:30pm but, unfortunately, it was delayed two hours. In that case, I would arrive in Wuhan at 1:30am and there would not be any public transportation. When two priest friends of mine heard this, they drove from the parish near my home to Wuhan to pick me up and the distance was about 300 kilometres. When we arrived at my home, it was about 5am. They didn't sleep for a second that night because of me and I didn't miss Mum's funeral held that morning.

I would like to thank all the above mentioned people and all those whom I don't mention here but helped me in one way or another. I believe that they helped me because there is love in their hearts and the love comes from our Creator who is love. That is why I call this trip a trip of love. After all of this, I believe even stronger that love is everything and the power of love is the greatest one.

Also, I would like to take this opportunity to thank all those who have prayed for the repose of the soul of Mum, the recovery of Dad and the peace of all my family. Special thanks to Deacon Mike for celebrating the memorial liturgy for Mum and writing reflections for our newsletter, and to Fr John, Fr Bavin, and Fr Harry for celebrating Mass for our parish during my absence. God bless you and peace be with you all.

The practical implementation and strategies of this policy also protect those in ministry in the church. This choice of date provides a link to the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, October 7th, When we pray the rosary the hope is we will "deepen our faith, prompt a conversion of heart and strengthen our will to follow Christ" (Catechism) and this is a great way to view Safeguarding as well!.
