From the Pastor's Desk

John 21:1-19. Are We Reaching Out To Others And Witness His Presence in the Midst of Us?

The post resurrection appearance of Jesus on lake Tiberius is the gospel text for today. The focus of the gospel is on Jesus and on his Church. There are three parts to this story. The firrst part deals with the miraculous catch of fish, the second part is the recognition of the risen Lord by the disciples, and the third part is the dialogue with Peter. The text begins with Peter telling his companions that he is going fishing. They affirm that they will go with and collaborate with Peter. But despite their efforts, they don't have a catch. Jesus appears on the shore and makes a turn in the effort of these fisherman. The second part of the story narrates their recognition of the risen Lord. The number of the fish caught is 153. It is not sure what it really means. May be, to state that this narration is an eye witness account of what really happened, and thus gives precision and clarity. Or as some scholars claim, that 153 was the number of species of fish known to Greek zoologists of that time. So, no one is excluded in the catch, connecting it to the universal nature of the Church. All are included. All are welcome. Dialogue with Peter is the third part and the questions are totally different. First one includes other disciples, the boat, the nets, and the fish. Jesus is asking Peter weather Peter loves him more than he loves the other disciples, and his livelihood. The second one is direct and involves only Jesus and Peter. The tird question seems similar to the second, but is different because it is about friendship. Simon, son of John, are you my friend? And Peter states that he is, and affirms his willingness to die for Jesus.

The call to follow Jesus today will continue to be heard as long as there are people who dare to open their hearts to his invitation. It is a call to be a witness in the world even to the point of losing one's life for the sake of Christ and his Gospel. Jesus the risen one lives through these witnesses and their readiness to reach out others in love. And this itself is a martyrdom and losing one's life for the sake of the Lord, so that Jesus the Risen Lord makes his presence in the midst of the world.




