## 10th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year B)

### 10th June 2018

Readings: Genesis 3:9-15      2 Corinthians 4:13—5:1      Mark 3:20-35

### *Family, School and Parish combined Mass*

We are celebrating our family, school and Parish combined Mass at 9am this Sunday. Our Parish and school try to arrange such a Mass several times a year. Through worshipping God together in Eucharist, we try to bridge between our family, school and Parish. By God's grace, we hope we can communicate and collaborate with each other better, more effectively and efficiently. Then we believe we will create a better environment in which children can happily learn knowledge and skills while gradually deepening their faith. As we know, the Eucharist is the fountain and summit of faithful life. Taking our students to Mass we receive this sacred sacrament together with them. From this we draw spiritual nourishment and, through this, we offer the highest form of worship to God. In celebrating this sacrament, we are walking to our Lord.

I would like to take this opportunity to share my personal understanding about the relationship between the family, school and the parish (the Church) in education. In the process of educating children, the family, school and parish respectively play different important roles and each of them is indispensable. Most people understand the importance of roles played by families and schools and mainly focus on them. And many of them are not very clear about the role played by the Church and think the role may or may not be needed. This understanding is incomplete and wrong.

In my view, there are three main aspects in education: 1. The formation of good living habits and independence; 2. The teaching of knowledge, skills and expertise; 3. The cultivation of love, mercy, compassion, forgiveness, justice and responsibility, and the understanding and control of life direction. These three aspects belong to three different fields and partly overlap one another in some sense as well. Families, schools and the Church can have influence on them all but the different roles played by them are distinctive and not replaceable. Generally speaking, families take the main responsibility of the first aspect; schools are responsible for the second one; and the Church focuses on the third one. The periods of time covered by families, schools and the Church are not the same either. The guidance of parents to children is mainly during the period between birth and secondary school, after that, the influence of parents will considerably decrease; and the teaching of schools is certainly limited to the schooling period; but for good Christians, the Church can cover their whole lifetime, from cradle to grave.

It is obvious that the Church plays an even more important role in education. As far as the content of education is concerned, the Church stresses ethics, paying more attention to love and mercy, namely, the aspect of spirituality. As far as the period of influence is concerned, children will grow up and leave the family. Similarly, they will graduate from and leave schools. However, as Christians, if they wish, they can go to church for their whole lifetime. In the Church, they can listen to the Word of God, learn His love, mercy and forgiveness, receive His sacraments by which they draw spiritual energy and strength, and attend the communal activities by which they can possibly enjoy life-long friendship and company.

Dear friends, let us try to help our family, school and parish cooperate better, through which, we try to form our children into good citizens and Christians who are independent, well-trained in knowledge, skills and expertise and more importantly, full of love and compassion.
