# The Most Holy Trinity 11th June 2017

(Year A Readings: Exodus 34:4-6, 8-9\*2 Corinthians 13:11-13\* John 3:16-18)

# Many can become one in love

Today we celebrate the mystery of the Trinity. As we all know, "the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life" (CCC 234). And it is the greatest one. No one can comprehend it completely. However, we believe that God wouldn't reveal to us this mystery for no reason. If we study and meditate on it more often, we will learn something from it that can better our lives and deepen our faith. Let us have a closer look at the mystery.

We do not confess three Gods, but one God in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The divine persons do not share the one divinity among themselves but each of them is God, whole and entire. The divine persons are really distinct from one another. God is one but not solitary. Father, Son and Holy Spirit are not simply names designating modalities of the divine being (CCC 253, 254). This is really very difficult to comprehend or explain. But one thing is very clear. Three means many while one represents wholeness and unity. And we know that "God is love" (1 John 4:16). So we can at least get one simple truth from the mystery: in love, the beings that are really distinct from one another can be united as one. Simply put, many can become one in love.

In fact, this is the image of our Church. Our Church must be like this: all of us are different from one another but we should be one in the love of the Holy Trinity. In the early Church, St Paul tried everything possible in order to make it happen. "To the Jews I became as a Jew, in order to win Jews. To those under the law I became as one under the law so that I might win those under the law. .... I have become all things to all people, that I might by all means save some." (1 Cor 9:20-22). In this way, St Paul gathered all different people together to become a new creation in Christ, and in and through love, to make them, though many, as one body of Christ. That is why St Paul declared: "there is no longer Jews or Greek, there is no longer slave or free, there is no longer male and female; for all of you are one in Christ Jesus" (Gal 3:28).

Australia is an immigrant country. In this beautiful country, there are many people who are from all different parts of the planet. We have different languages, cultures and food customs but we are one country. So is our parish. St Peter's Parish is comprised of parishioners from different countries and cultures. First of all, I, as your Parish Priest, am from China. Apart from Aussies, among us are Indians, Koreans, Italians, and many others. We are quite different but we all are Catholics. We all come to St Peter's Church to attend Mass and worship God. In the love of the Holy Trinity, we, though many and different, have formed one beautiful parish, St Peter's, Rochedale.

Dear friends, as we are celebrating this important solemnity, let us remind ourselves to love one another deeper and better. This way, our parish will become even more attractive, active, united and fuller because of love. This way, living in the community of love, we will comprehend the mystery of the Holy Trinity deeper and better.


