From the Pastor's Desk

Luke 07:36 -08: 03. Are We Blind to Our Own Sin?

Today's readings give us an invitation to repent, do penance and renew our lives instead of carrying the heavy baggage of our own sins. Our God is a God who always tries to, not punish, but to rehabilitate sinners so that all of us may be made whole and experience inner peace and harmony. So today we celebrate the forgiveness of God and our own means to experience it. In the first reading, David's sincere repentance for his very grave sins of lust, murder, adultery and deceit is met by God's gracious and loving pardon. The response today, (Psalm 51) has been regarded as David's own prayer of repentance. It includes an acknowledgement that the injustice done against another is a sin against God himself, in the same way a good deed done to another is a deed done to God: having sinned against none other than you. St Paul, in the second reading reminds us that it is by faith in Jesus that we are saved. He says that it is the realization that Christ died for us and lives in us that should bring us to true repentance, leading to newness of life in Christ. Paul suggests that the experience of forgiveness is made available to all sinners through the saving Cross of Jesus. Giving us the story of true repentance and conversion of a public sinner, today's Gospel invites us to true repentance and renewal, Also, Jesus challenges us through the Gospel story to have a forgiving attitude towards others and a deep awareness of our own personal need for God's grace and forgiveness. When the sinful woman begins to weep and to wash the feet of Jesus with her tears, Jesus sees her heart and accepts her and forgives her ways. The one to whom little is forgiven, loves little. So we come with this question today, directed to our hearts: how much has been forgiven me? It is a wonderful question for us to ponder this week, even for the whole of our life.

We have our *Archbishop's pastoral visit in July 15th -17th*, and it is a great time to celebrate our faith as St Peter's Community with our shepherd His Grace Mark Coleridge our archbishop. *St Peter's School celebrates is 40th anniversary* and a great time for the Community of St Peter to pride ourselves in this great event and thank the gifts we have received from God. Next Friday we have our 35 children who will receive the sacrament of Confirmation after great preparation. I thank those children and their families for this great step in their life. Also, a *Big Thank you to the team* - John Donohue (the Coordinator), Josephine Cullen, and Stephanie Lenihan, and Paul Rees (the APRE at the School) - who helped these children with proper instruction and guidance. I recommend these children in a special way to your prayers and support so that they really experience the Holy Spirit in their future journey.





20th Anniversary Blackhawk Disaster: This weekend, the Parish and the nation pause to remember the twentieth anniversary of the tragic loss of 17 young men in the Blackhawk disaster, outside of Townsville on 12th June, 1996. Our local community suffered the loss of 26 year old Sig. Hendrik (Rick) Peeters of the S.A.S. Regiment, killed with sixteen other servicemen from both the Regiment and the Royal Australian Air Force in the collision of helicopters on a training mission. A memorial Mass was offered for Rick and his comrades and the plaque on our Parish Memorial Wall commemorates this tragedy for all time. Lest we forget.
