From the Pastor's Desk

John 8:1-11. Put the Past Behind and Look to a Bright Future. Some years ago a lady wrote to the famous advice columnist Ann Landers and asked this question: Do all men cheat on their wives? I have been suspicious of my husband for some time. I even hired a private detective to trail him, but he couldn't come up with a thing. I went to a lawyer. He told me to grow up and accept the fact that all husbands fool around. Do they?" Ann Landers very wisely replied, "No. There are plenty of married men who never cheat, and your husband could be one of them. The only thing you can be fairly sure of is that your lawver cheats on his wife." Cheating on one's wife or husband is called adultery in the Bible. And it is prohibited by the Sixth Commandment, Today's Gospel story from John is a story of a woman caught in adultery (but the man is not brought in!) and Jesus is not condemning her, but sends her away with, "go away and sin no more." What a great story to listen to as we are nearing to the finish of our Lenten journey during this Year of Mercy!

There is very definitely a theme running through all of our readings today which might be proclaimed as: Forget what has happened in the past and look to the future. When Jesus has managed to dismiss all the naysayers who wanted to kill the woman caught in adultery, he is left alone with her. In a confessional moment, Jesus, the Face of God's Mercy, forgives her past and has prompted her to look to the future: Go and sin no more. In the reading of Isaiah, God is speaking and is telling his people not to bother even remembering the exodus from Egypt and the miracles in the desert because in the future God is going to do even more remarkable things for them. Put the past behind them and look to a bright future. Paul too says that he does only one thing: he forgets what lies behind and strains forward to what lies ahead. And we have our Lenten Reconciliation Rite on Monday 14th at 7.30 pm, and it is a very positive moment for all of us learning to follow the Lord Jesus as best we can, always relying on his love and forgiveness.
