# 2019, Year of Indigenous Languages

Languages are the greatest and most important invention of humankind. In his first letter to the Corinthians: 14-10, St Paul said: "There are doubtless

many languages in the world, and none is without meaning."

"It is through language that we communicate with the world, define our identity, express our history and culture, learn, defend our human rights and participate in all aspects of society, to name but a few. Through language, people preserve their community's history, customs and traditions, memory, unique modes of thinking, meaning and expression.....A person's right to use his or her chosen language is a prerequisite for freedom of thought, opinion and expression... Many of us take it for granted that we can conduct our lives in our home languages without any constraints or prejudice. But this is not the case for everyone. It is for this reason that the United Nations chose to dedicate a whole year to indigenous languages, to encourage urgent action to speak, revitalise and promote them." (UNESCO www.firstlanguages.org.au)

According to research there existed 31,000 languages in the course of human history (Richard Armstrong, Episode 2723). Currently there are roughly between 6000 to 7000 languages. Some of these are dying particularly those that do not have a standard written form.

On the Australian continent, at the time of European settlement, 250 Indigenous languages and 800 dialectal varieties were spoken. Many of the languages are lost or in danger. (Creative Spirits, 8/2/19) Languages have died for a variety of reasons but their death had a profound impact upon many indigenous communities. Brook Joy, AIATSIS, Survey 2014 writes: "Strong cultural identity enables one to feel proud of themselves and speaking and maintaining one's language raises self-esteem and enables one to feel good about themselves. Traditional language is important for maintaining strong cultural connections. Where traditional languages have been taken away from communities, a sense of loss, grief, and inadequacy develops. To keep communities and generations strong, traditional languages being passed from one generation to another is vital."

Without intervention indigenous languages will cease to exist in Australia in the next 10 to 30 years according to Tom Calma (ATSI Justice Commissioner 2010). The time has come for Australians to seriously consider how to revive and preserve the oldest languages spoken on our continent. After all, these languages are the heritage of all Australians.

Around the country a great deal is happening to preserve indigenous languages. There are language broadcasts in the first language of their listeners. Libraries are leading the way by compiling language tapes and dictionaries and providing training courses. A 50 cent coin has been especially minted for the occasion.

In our Logan area, under the guidance of the Yugambeh Museum, 2 Plantation Rd, Beenleigh, Borobi, the popular mascot of the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games is used in an animated form to teach the Yugambeh language to primary school students. Currently about 20 schools, including St Paul's in Woodridge, are teaching the language from Prep up to grade 3. A wonderful start. Check out the Borobi displays on the church verandah.
