From the Pastor's Desk

Luke 18:1-8: Prayer - Perseverance in Prayer, Trust in Prayer, and Trust in God as We Pray.

The main message for us as Catholics and Christians today is Perseverance, the idea that we steadfastly continue doing what we are doing until we get it right or until we get what we want. The readings are also about the trustworthiness and justice of God that reaches out to the poor and the weak, enabling them to fight against injustices they face in their life. In the First Reading, Moses, after sending Joshua and the force to fight against Amalek, is presented as making tireless intercession to God with constancy for the victory of the Israel's army. In the Second Reading, St Paul instructs Timothy to persevere in his ministry, to proclaim the Word of God, with persistence in all situations and to use it 'to correct, reprove, and appeal with patience'. By introducing the parable of the unjust judge and the persistent widow in today's Gospel, Jesus 'emphasizes the 'necessity of praying always and not losing heart'. Praying constantly is Faith in action. Jesus presents the widow in the Gospel as a model of the trust and tenacity with which his disciples are to pray. The widow was asking for justice for her which God would want her to demand. Certainly Jesus is not saving God is like the unjust judge, a point he makes at the conclusion, but he is asking how many people would be willing to persevere as the widow did.

Rome was not built on a day: No great work can never be achieved without long and patient effort. Look at the art of Michelangelo, the Beethoven concertos, or any magnificent art piece. How many chisel-strokes to release the Pieta from its marble shroud? How many brush-strokes to transfer the Last Judgement from Michelangelo's teeming imagination to the sanctuary wall of the Sistine Chapel? And our main work is achieving salvation for us and for the whole world. To achieve it, we must co-operate vigorously with God, and in a sense wrestle with Him as Jacob did. We had our Ministry Expo last weekend, a way of proclaiming our faith in God as a Community and to thank the Lord for this gift of Faith and to do service because we are people for the sake of the Gospel invited to witness him in the midst of the society. I thank all of you, especially the Parish Pastoral Council members and all the leaders/members of the different ministries for their diligence, service, time and dedication. God bless you and our St Peter's Community.

In many ways, volunteers share the duties and rights of an employee of an organisation and as such we are required to have a complete list of volunteers just as a business would have a list of employees. Much of this is coming out as a result of a variety of legal action, including the Royal Commission. All Parish Volunteers will need to complete a Volunteer Data Form and sign the Code of Ethical Behaviour and return both to Julie. Volunteers who work with children still have to hold or successfully apply for a current Queensland Government Blue Card. Volunteers who visit vulnerable adults in their homes or Nursing homes and volunteers who work in the finance area of the Parish will need to consent to a Police Check.
