Planned Giving Update

The Parish of Saint Peter's in Rochedale was established in 1974 and has since developed into a vibrant Catholic community committed to the spiritual and temporal needs of a growing community. To ensure that St Peter's is best equipped to meet the financial commitments of the parish, an invigorated Planned Giving Program commenced in November 2017. This program relied on the good will of all parishioners to contribute where possible in the various methods of making regular contributions to parish funding. A sound financial footing enables St Peter's to meet, among other things, capital repayments on parish projects, salaries and wages, parish running costs/maintenance and the support of the various parish ministries.

The first review of the current program in 2018 saw a welcome increase in what had been, a declining revenue base. The Parish appeared to be on track to regain the level of income that could reasonably be expected to meet current and new ministry commitments. The Planned Giving Team will address each mass this weekend about the 2019 review. This review has indicated a slow decline (6%) in the gifting commitments made earlier in the program, thus giving cause for some concern about the ability of the Parish to stay on budget and meet commitments. The status of financial gifting can be fluid as parishioners move out of the parish and incoming parishioners are yet to commit to the Planned Giving Program.

The Parishioners of St Peter's have shown over the years to be a very generous community and have in recent times indicated a willingness to embrace the electronic method of gifting. The number of parishioners who are moving to this preferred method is slowly increasing. The Planned Giving Team will today outline the range of options available for gifting and to identify the method that best suits personal situations. It is not too late to be a member of the Planned Giving Program. Personal information relating to any gift and credit card details are treated in strictest confidence. Gifting information envelopes containing the yellow commitment card are available at the church front door and information is detailed in the parish newsletter.

Some future options including using a 'pay wave' style of collection plate is being trialled in a number of parishes in the Brisbane Archdiocese. Our parish is keen to obtain the evaluation of what appears to be another option to meeting the financial arrangements of many people in today's world.

Since the establishment of St Peter's Parish in 1974 we have experienced wonderful support from our parishioners across a range of endeavours to enable us to fulfil our mission as a Catholic Community. It is important that we acknowledge this support and thank all parishioners who have been supporting the parish financially over these years and to thank the new parishioners who have committed financially to our planned giving program.

RELIGIOUS LEADERS COMMON STATEMENT ON END OF LIFE CARE

As the head of the Archdiocese of Brisbane, I have recently signed a joint statement on the provision of end of life care. This was done in unison with 15 of my fellow religious leaders here in Queensland, all of whom are committed to the proper funding and availability of palliative care. We believe that our society should be a caring and compassionate one, founded on the promotion of human dignity, human freedom and the common good.

Death is part of life. Dying well is an important part of what it means to flourish as individuals and communities. We maintain that 'voluntary assisted dying' is not dying well and legalising this practice would undermine the vision for a flourishing Queensland by undermining human freedom, human dignity, and the common good. We instead support high-quality palliative care, better conversations about death and dying and provision for the spiritual dimension of healing such as chaplaincy and pastoral care.


