# Fourth Sunday of Advent—Year A 18th December 2016

#### Pastor's Note:

Jesus Saves and is God-With-Us, Emmanuel (Isaiah 7:10-14;Rom.1:1-7; Matthew 1:18-25).

The first reading presents the meeting between Isiah and the king Ahaz. In this meeting, the reluctance of the king to ask for a sign is interpreted by the prophet Isiah as a failure of faith, an unwillingness to be reassured by God. The sign will be given even though unasked for. The immediate reference is to the child who would be born to Ahaz, who was to become King Hezekiah. However, the history tells that though he began well with religious reforms, gradually turned away from the Lord and so the people began to look for another messiah. And thus it becomes a long expectation for a saviour and is seen as direct prophesy about Jesus. Paul's letter to the Romans in today's second reading tells that Paul is chosen by the Lord to be a servant and an apostle, especially chosen by Christ to preach the good news that God had promised long ago. The Son of God and descendant of David was born a man. Truly and fully a man, he was proclaimed the Son of God through his resurrection from the dead. And Paul invites all to belong to this Son of God, Jesus Christ who is our saviour.

The Gospel text is from Matthew's Infancy Narrative and contains the prophesy of Isaiah found in today's first reading. Matthew uses Joseph's dream as a tool with which to answer questions that may have risen about the virginal conception of Jesus. His intention is to show Jesus as a descendant of David and the focus on his story is on Joseph, who is a descendant of David, as Matthew presents the story. Jesus, the Son of David is also Son of God as indicated by the virginal birth prophesy, and the one who will save all people from sin. In this, he is Emmanuel, God with us, not in judgement, but grace. Finally, our advent waiting is to bear fruit. Sunday by Sunday prophet Isaiah has brought to life the ancient hopes, promises and dreams of God's people; and along the way the apostle Paul has exhorted us to patience and tolerance. Thus the prophet Isaiah allows Matthew to adopt and adapt the prophesy to the House of David via King Ahaz: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son and they will call him Emmanuel, a name which means 'God with us'. Thus Jesus is the Christ, the Messiah, is son of David and Son of God. The good news is that we need never fear God, since he is God with us. Our response to him must only be a response of love. God's love is given freely in Jesus. Receive it with openness and humility like the shepherds and Wise Kings.
