Pastor's Note: Matthew 5:38-48 Jesus Directs Us As His Disciples

This Sunday's gospel reading is taken from the section in known as the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew's Chapters 5-7). Matthew summarizes the teaching of Jesus on a variety of life issues such as anger, adultery, retaliation, alms-giving, prayer, money, judging others, offering sacrifices, and discipleship or following Jesus. We all like our friends ad family members and we want to remember their birthdays and other special occasions. If they need our help, most of the time we are glad to be able to lend a hand, offer a listening ear, share our time or give some useful advice. In contrast, we are not quite so kind to the people we dislike. If we really dislike them, to the point of hatred, then we may be tempted to treat them unjustly or, at least, damage their character by slandering them and gossiping about them. For us Christians this type of behaviour is not welcome precisely because Jesus in the Gospel explicitly forbade it. Jesus teaches us how to respond to those who do us evil. He tells us to love them, and to pray for those who persecute us. If we live in the wisdom of Jesus, we can be certain that we are children of the heavenly Father because love is the nature of divine life. It means to love one another simply because we are begotten of God, and God is
