# **Everything is in God's Hands**

There are many things in human life that cannot be predicted. Last year, after my Dad's funeral, a friend of mine said to me: "Baiyi, you may not come back and visit us in the future as often as in the past, as both your parents have passed away now. However, I still hope I can see you a lot as we are good friends." I agreed with him. At that moment, I thought to myself, perhaps, I would be able to see more of the world in the next few years. When my parents were getting on in years, I had spent as much time as possible with them during my holidays. Then I had had chances to see my friends in China at least once a year. However, I hadn't had a chance to travel to anywhere else.

Then, in September last year, my brother, Zhiding Gong, was diagnosed with terminal cancer. I wanted to spend time with him before his illness became too debilitating. So I decided to visit him. All my siblings, my two sisters-in-law and I travelled together for a week. Then, Zhiding and I went on alone for another week. We had some quality time, together. Of course, before I left China for Australia, I visited my friend mentioned above and some others as well. Though they felt very sorry for my brother, my friends were glad to see

At the beginning of 2019, my sister's son decided to get married on 30<sup>th</sup> April. The whole family was hoping that I, the priest from the family, who had already married so many couples, could officiate at the wedding of my own nephew. As I knew that my brother could die at any time and it would be hard for me to visit China twice in a year, I told my nephew the difficulty of the situation. He understood my predicament and said to me: "Please offer a special Mass for my marriage if you can't make it".

On the 7<sup>th</sup> April, I was told that my brother was very low. I knew his last days were approaching. The timing wasn't good as Holy Week was only a week away. I'd love to be with my parishioners during this special time. So I was planning to return to Rochedale on Holy Thursday morning. After I arrived home in China, my brother's condition was really "up-and-down". We all knew he was dying soon, but nobody could tell us when exactly. At the suggestion of our Parish Pastoral Council, and with the support and approval of the Archdiocese, I decided to take my annual leave to continue to be with my family. I changed my air tickets on Holy Monday. My brother died two days later.

After the funeral, we had one week to adjust our hearts for my nephew's wedding. It was such a big success. Within one month, in my personal life, not only was there a sad occasion, but a happy one as well. I know that's life. "For everything, there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven: a time to weep, and a time to laugh; a time to mourn, and a time to dance." (Ecclesiastes 3:1,4). I understand I can't predict anything but I know everything's in God's hands. Following His Will is always the best way. Thank God for everything. I thank all those who have prayed for my brother, my family and me and all those who have offered assistance, in any form, during my absence.
