### 12th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C 19th June 2016

From the Pastor's Desk

Luke 9:18-24. Do We Reveal Jesus to the World?

The First reading from the prophet Zechariah presents a figure who comes to save the people, and could be seen even by the Jewish scholars as a Messianic figure. The words of the prophecy are so strong: they shall look on him whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him as one mourns for an only son, and they shall grieve over him as one grieves over a firstborn. We hear about this prophecy, may be on a Good Friday, when we talk about the suffering of Jesus as seen in the John's Gospel. Paul's letter to the Galatians assures us that we are all one in Christ Jesus. We are born different from one another and yet called to be one in the Lord. We are all children of the promise made to Abraham. Faith is at the heart of this transformation into God's chosen people. Faith allows us to live for the Kingdom and accept the sufferings of this life as part of a transformation into God's children who will reveal Jesus to the world.

Jesus knows that he will suffer and die. He keeps on living in the direction of dying. He invites us also to live in the direction of dying by taking up the cross and following him. Jesus is clear in his teaching: if you want to save your life here, you are going to lose. If you are willing to give up your life here for the sake of the Kingdom, you will save it. We don't often like to hear such words put in front of us too forcefully! Jesus reminds us that living is living for the Kingdom, and not just having a good time here with the pleasures and joys of this world. There must be a clear focus in our lives: seeking to follow the Lord and taking up the Cross daily in order to be a saviour like him/to follow him. So, this Sunday's Gospel explains the basis of our Faith as the acceptance of Jesus as the Christ/ Lord and Saviour. It also tells us that Jesus became Christ/Saviour by his suffering, death and resurrection. And, it outlines for us the three requirements of Christian discipleship, namely, dying to oneself, taking up one's cross, and following Jesus our Master. Jesus must enter into our living experience, loving us, forgiving us, helping us and transforming our lives and outlook. Then we need to surrender our life to Jesus whom we experience as our Saviour and then take up the cross and follow his way, and that is our Christian living.
