# Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord - Year C 20th March 2016

From the Pastor's Desk

Luke 22:14-23:56: Walk With Jesus and Follow the Way

Constantine the Great was the first Christian Roman emperor. His father Constantius I who succeeded Diocletian as emperor in 305 AD was a pagan with a soft heart for Christians. When he ascended the throne, he discovered that many Christians held important jobs in the Government and in the court. So he issued an executive order to all those Christians: "Either give up Christ or give up your jobs." The great majority of Christians, to his surprise, gave up their jobs rather than disowning Christ! The emperor was pleased with the majority who showed the courage of their convictions and gave their jobs back to them saying: "If you will not be true to your God you will not be true to me either."

The Son of Man hanging on the Cross is what Passion Sunday is all about. This Sunday is also Palm Sunday, since palm branches are distributed. However, the focus is on betrayal, arrest, suffering, and crucifixion of Jesus rather than his triumphal entry into Jerusalem just before his death. And we join today with the crowd in spirit to declare our loyalty to Jesus Christ and fidelity to his teachings by this active participation in the Palm Sunday liturgy. The first reading from the prophet Isaiah, shows us that even before Jesus, holy people could begin to understand that someone could give his life for others and accept suffering for their sake. The second reading is from the letter to Philippians and teaches us that God is even willing to take on our humanity to suffer with us and for us - and ultimately willing to die so that we might live. Then we return to the Passion narration of Jesus. this year from the Gospel of Luke. Most of us never have to see the reality of someone being put to death. So we have to be united with Christ and with those who are killed because they believe, who are willing to die for their faith than to renounce it. Do I want to follow the way of the Lord? It may cost me my life, but that is the way our Lord Jesus walked.
