Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe Year C

Pastor's Note:

The Feast of Christ the King of the Universe (Last Sunday of the Year C). Luke 23:35-43: Lord Thy Kingdom Come

Way back in January we began the liturgical year by celebrating the Baptism of Jesus when a voice was heard calling him 'the beloved son'. During the year we have greeted Jesus under all the news of him we find in the gospels. Now, today, at the end we greet him with the whole-embracing title: Jesus Christ, Universal King. The Christ is the one who will gather all together at the end of time, the one who will judge the living and the dead, and then present his kingdom to the Father. In our pilgrimage of faith that kingdom of justice, truth, and peace is to be our beacon, and Christ our guide. The Gospel of Luke we have is the crucifixion scene immediately before his account of the death on the Cross, and the gospel writer wants us to have a direct vision of what kind of king he is and the nature of his kingdom. The key transition moment is verse 39: 'One of the criminals who were hanged railed at him, saying, "Are you not the Christ? Save yourself and us!" In Mark and Matthew there are no words given to those crucified with Jesus, so the whole section verse 39-43 is found only in Luke. One of the criminals behaves exactly like the chief priests, elders and soldiers and mocks Jesus using their very words. Then there is the contrast of the other criminal, who can see both himself, his predicament, and the predicament of all three of them, and can ask for mercy. In Year C we have been reading the gospel of Luke over many Sundays and have been privileged to see how the great mystery of God's universal love and mercy is revealed in the person of Jesus. It is appropriate then on this feast to focus on Jesus on the cross granting pardon to the repentant criminal. For Luke this aspect of the kingdom of God has been central: Jesus has come to bring the healing forgiveness of God to all who seek him.

A Personal Note: My Visa status 457 is for four years and it expires by the middle of March 2017. Now either I have to process application for a new visa or leave Australia before the expiry date. Because of my prior commitments back in India, teaching in two major seminaries and being part of *Prasada: an Institute for Integral Formation in Mysore* near the big city of Bangalore, and my siblings, especially my brother, and many of the family members and friends, strongly suggest my return, I decided not to get a new visa, but to return to India before I am illegal here. *So I finish as your parish priest by the end of February 2017*. I start my 40th year of priestly ministry in March 2017 as well. I had consulted with the archbishop and my superiors before this decision was made and this is the best I could do at this time.
