# Repent, and believe the Good News

In today's Gospel, Jesus said, "The time has come and the kingdom of God is close at hand. Repent, and believe the Good News." Jesus taught us that our direction in life should be towards the kingdom of God and believing the Good News is the way to this. Firstly, we should review our direction in life: Are we trying our best to journey along the way to the kingdom of God? This kingdom is a kingdom of love. Words and actions of love, as required by the Good News, lead to the kingdom of God. In contrast, any words and actions seeking power, fame, excess and self-indulgence take us away from the kingdom of God. If we are clever, work hard and have good opportunities, but get the direction of life wrong, over a long period of time, we will get further and further away from worthy life goals.

In Christian life, repentance has two dimensions. Firstly, we must realise that we have taken the wrong direction. We acknowledge that sometimes our words and actions have not conformed to the values of the Good News. Then we feel sincerely sorry for our wrongdoings. Secondly, we must change this by giving up all the wrong words and actions we had previously and by trying to live out the Good News. Believing the Good News has two dimensions, as well. Firstly, we have faith in the Good News and accept it wholeheartedly. Secondly, we follow it closely in our everyday living. Let the Good News become our highest guiding principle in life.

Dear friends, if we have any words and actions that don't conform to the teachings of the Good News, we are walking in the opposite direction to the kingdom of God. If we continue to use such words and actions in any way or any sense, then we are not fully repentant. And if we just listen to Jesus' teaching in liturgy and don't let these teachings influence our every word and action, we don't really believe the Good News. My brothers and sisters let us follow Jesus' words, repent, believe and live the Good News.
