We greatly value the work of the Pastoral Council in building and nurturing our faith community. Through the faith and works of the whole community and the goodness and generosity of a God who never ceases to provide for our needs, the Pastoral Council leads us in making a difference in the lives of people. It is time to thank a number of our Pastoral Councillors who have completed their term and to invite all members of our parish to prayerfully and thoughtfully discern new members.

Over the next three weeks, your newsletter will contain a series of inserts. They will contain information about what it means to be a parish with its primary purpose to carry on the Mission of Christ, and the work of great importance this entails, and to which all people in the parish, by nature of their Baptism, are called in 'co-responsible' ministry with the priest.

The parish in today's world is very different from the parish of even fifty years ago. Society is different and people are different, but the purpose of the parish is more relevant than ever in making God's reign visible within, and beyond the parish, in an increasingly fragmented and lonely world. Our community is already different through the witness of your faith over many years and we will strive to continue to speak to the wider community and to the world of the Kingdom values of love, peace, justice and compassion as they are lived out by every member of our parish community.

In the The Joy of the Gospel (no 28) Pope Francis puts it this way:

The parish is not an outdated institution ... The parish continues to be 'the Church living in the midst of the homes of her sons and daughters'. This presumes that it really is in contact with the homes and the lives of its people, and does not become a useless structure out of touch with people or a self-absorbed cluster made up of a chosen few. The parish is the presence of the Church in a given territory, an environment for hearing God's word, for growth in the Christian life, for dialogue, proclamation, charitable outreach, worship and celebration. In all its activities, the parish encourages and trains its members to be evangelisers. It is a community of communities, a sanctuary where the thirsty come to drink in the midst of their journey, and a centre of constant missionary outreach....
