From the Pastor's Desk

Luke 9:51-62. Work of the Kingdom Will Go On.... Through You and Me.

The story of the first reading is the prophet Elijah's endorsement of Elisha as his successor and is brief but charged with energy and task. In the lead-up to this episode Elijah has fled for his life from the vengeful queen Jezebel, is fed in the wilderness by the angel of the Lord, and journeys for forty days and nights to the holy mountain of Horeb. There he encounters God 'in the sheer sound of silence' and is instructed to anoint Elisha as his successor. So the abruptness and precision in the whole ceremony, for the prophet is on his for his own life! Elijah is not waiting to anoint Elisha but throws his cloak over him. Elisha appears to be ready for his calling, asking to be allowed to bid farewell to his parents first. A reasonable and normal way of leaving them for his future mission. When challenged by Elijah, he acts decisively, breaking totally from his past by slaughtering his oxen and burning his plough. We will see parallels in the gospels where the ready response of the fishermen and tax collectors to Jesus' call.

Today's Gospel text narrates the life and death that awaits Jesus and the uncompromising demands to his would-be disciples set by the their Master. Jesus resolutely took the road to Jerusalem, and it is not the geographic travel that matters, but the aim and destination await there for Jesus and his purpose in teaching his disciples on the way to Jerusalem. Jesus highlights his own unwavering determination to see his mission through to its completion. The message is clear to his disciples and readers: following him is costly and must be unconditional. 'Rejection' seems to be part of this calling, for it is not human works called to be done; but divine way of fulfilling the mission of Christ Jesus. Even in today's world we hear so many stories of missionaries tortured, ill-treated and murdered for the mission they are trying to establish - bringing God's own kingdom on earth through the work. It seems that we too have to be a sharer in the mission and be an agent of peace, love, joy and mercy in today's world and thus a true disciple of Christ. Next Sunday we celebrate the Feast of St Peter, our parish Feast. We have a mission statement and let us uphold to its living of it in our different ministries and mission.
