From the Pastor's Desk

Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ:

Luke 9:11-17. Becoming Bread and wine for the World.

This feast originated in the Belgian city of Liege in the 13th Century. Pope Urban IV decreed that the feast be celebrated by the whole Western Church. From its beginnings through to the reforms of the Second Vatican Council, the popular focus of the feast was on the presence of Christ in the consecrated bread, the Blessed sacrament. Even today this limited understanding is reflected in its original Latin name, Corpus Christi. Today the feast focuses on the feast as a meal that reveals God's saving work for us in and through Jesus the Christ. By our communion in the Body and Blood of Christ - Eucharistic Celebration - we enter into the mystery of Jesus' self-giving to us in shared food and drink. So Eucharist is not a sacred object (Blessed sacrament), but first and foremost an action and a memorial that engages us personally and communally. It calls us while we do the memory of Jesus to break the bread and pour out the wine of our lives for the sake of the world. As followers of the Master we are challenged to be an answer to the hunger and thirst at all levels of the world.

We include in this feast many aspects of the Eucharist: The sacrifice of Jesus on the Cross: Jesus' sharing of his body and blood as a meal for the salvation of the world; and the belief of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. We are invited to be Eucharist in the sense that we are the people, inspired by the great sacrifice of Jesus, to the same act of satisfying the hunger and thirst of the world. People are deprived of food, water, a decent habitat, and even human dignity; and many areas of the world they are forced out of their own land/country and are refugees. We watch news on the TV and read and see a lot about them in social media. The world is becoming tragic in the lives of many in many nations. So this feast is igniting our hearts and minds to make a life style that compels us to opt for the right and support the people who are marginalized and deprived of human dignity. They have a right to be really human and live their lives fully with human dignity. This is the social dimension of the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ: Do this as a memorial of me.
