Readings: Isaiah 55:10-11 Romans 8:18-23 Matthew 13:1-23

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Sunday 16th July 2023

FOR OUR ELDERS: In early July Australia celebrates NAIDOC WEEK. It is an opportunity for everyone to come together to celebrate and learn about the rich history, the culture and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples as the oldest continuing culture on the planet. The NAIDOC theme this year is:" For Our Elders." Across every generation, Elders have played and are continuing to play an important role. They hold a prominent position in families and communities. They are respected for the wisdom and knowledge they hold. The list of prominent indigenous Elders past and present is long. One of the most distinguished Elders is Professor Tom Calma. In 2023 Professor Calma was honoured as Senior Australian of the Year for his 40 years of service to improve the lives of Indigenous people. In his acceptance speech Tom Calma stated that Indigenous people have been seen as a problem to be solved not as a partner and participant in determining their destiny. Their fate was determined by the whims of politics or by ever changing governments.

Professor Marcia Langdon, another Elder, expressed the same feelings as Professor Calma. There is a deep cynicism and despair in Aboriginal communities that any level of government will listen to them but will not be compelled to act. There is a lack of continuity in government services that a VOICE could address. Right from the start Marcia Langdon insisted that the VOICE must be enshrined in the Constitution. This demands a Referendum and is the only way the VOICE will be secure and consistent. A VOICE legislated by Parliament can be unlegislated again. The idea of the VOICE is derived from the 2017 Uluru Statement from the Heart that was presented to the people of Australia as a gift by Indigenous Australians. The VOICE is meant to be an advisory body to work directly with Parliament and the federal government on any laws, policies and programs affecting Indigenous people. Earlier this year, Prime Minister Anthony Albanese declared that there will be a Referendum to enshrine the VOICE in the Constitution, possibly in October. However and regrettably, the Referendum has already become politically charged. As Fr. Frank Brennan suggests, we need to start a respectful discussion in our parishes, families and work places so that we can hopefully get the country to vote Yes. Our faith teaches us that it is our vocation to be witnesses and agents of peace and justice in the midst of the political life of society.

The VOICE To Parliament Referendum provides us Catholics with an opportunity to draw upon our faith and moral grounding to make an informed decision. Archbishop Coleridge has already made his decision: "I am strongly committed to the VOICE. I have listened to important and convincing Indigenous voices on the topic." His endorsement is founded on Scripture and a history of dispossession of First Nation Peoples.

Guided by the Holy Spirit we pray that we will approach this very important moment in the history of Australia with a generous and hopeful heart as Peter, a child from Tasmania, expressed so beautifully:" Dear Aboriginal people. If I could vote Yes I would. Your voices are important to finding the heart of this country so it can be better again."

#### **FAITH MATTERS: MARY MAGDALENE**

(Feast day July 22nd)

Did you know that:

- 1. She probably came from the town of Magdala.
- 2. Mary Magdalene is probably best known for the fact that she had been set free from seven demons by Jesus. (Luke 8:2) Seven is associated with perfection in the Gospels.
- 3. Mary Magdalene travelled with and financially supported the work and ministry of Jesus and His followers. (Luke 8:2-3)
- 4. Mary Magdalene is probably the woman who anointed Jesus' feet with perfume and wept before Him. (John12:1-8) This act shows an extreme love for Jesus at the beginning of Holy Week. She was criticised for this by Judas.
- 5. Mary Magdalene was a leader among believers and she, along with other women leaders, faithfully supported Jesus' ministry.
- 6. Mary Magdalene was among the group of women who were at the foot of the cross and also with those who came to the empty tomb and found that Christ was risen. (John 20:1) It is clear that throughout Christ's ministry, Mary was a strong and faithful supporter. She was one of the few who did not flee when he was arrested and suffering. She was present at the foot of the cross.
- 7. John 20:10-18 tells us that Mary Magdalene is the very first one to whom Jesus appeared after the resurrection commissioning her to go and tell the others.
