### Third Sunday of Advent (Year B) 17th December 2023

Readings: Isaiah 61:1-2, 10-11 1 Thessalonians 5:16-24 John 1:6-8, 19-28

### Jesus' Light of the World

John the Baptist's job is "to prepare the way of the Lord and make straight His paths". Jesus' call, 'come and follow me' is for us like those fishermen and the purpose is to dispel darkness. Jesus said, "I am the light of the world, whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." As Christians, we cannot be selfish to enjoy Jesus' Light only for us but, we must let that light be reflected through our lives. Let us resolve to receive and then reflect the Light that Jesus is for the whole world. We take a candle into a room to dispel the darkness. Likewise, the Light of Jesus Christ must be taken into the darkness of sin that engulfs the lives of those who are not following Him. The light of Jesus is not just to light up street corners but to bring light to our heart so that we can see who God is and how He loves us.

Following Jesus is the condition of two promises in John 8:12. First, His followers will never walk in darkness and the second promise is that we will reflect the Light of Life. Just as He came as the Light of the world, He commands us to be "lights,". The emphasis here is maintaining a credible and obvious witness in the world, a witness that shows us to be faithful, trustworthy, sincere, earnest, and honest in all that we do. We live amid war, terrorism, genocide, and civil strife. Into this darkness comes the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

His call 'come and follow me' today is for us. The purpose is to dispel darkness that hovers over our world. It starts small with one person refusing to hate and resolving to love. It starts small with one person refusing to be selfish but resolving to reach out; with one person refusing to despair but resolving to hope. It starts with you and me. Jesus calls us to be fishers of people in our family, in our workplace and in our play. May be what we do seem so little but remember what the people are doing after the places of war in a particular area, they reach out to people, one at a time to the bereaved, to the little that they could do in consoling the affected. That is how the light dispels the darkness.

At this moment in history, we are a people who live under a cloud of uncertainty, under the threat from those who hate us. But we pray with the Psalmist: "The Lord is my light and my salvation, whom should, I fear? The Lord is my life's refuge, of whom should I be afraid? Wait for the Lord with courage, be stout-hearted and wait for the Lord."

#### The Advent wreath and candles

The wreath reminds us of both the immortality of our souls and God's promise of everlasting life to us through Christ.

First candle / Sunday: HOPE (The Prophecy Candle). Second candle / Sunday: PEACE (The Bethlehem Candle)

Third candle / Sunday: JOY (The Shepherd's Candle): this candle reflects the joy that comes through Jesus' arrival,

and through the salvation he has gifted us.

Fourth candle / Sunday: LOVE (The Angel's Candle).



## FAITH MATTERS: REJOICE!

On this Gaudate (Rejoicing) Sunday we light the pink Shepherd's candle, in the liturgical colour for Joy.

We rejoice: the Second Preface for Advent has cues for us to express our joy in this week of Advent - for all the oracles and prophets foretold him, the Virgin Mother longed for him with love beyond all telling, John the Baptist sang of his coming and proclaimed his presence when he came (1)

**Pray with joyful longing:** in the words of St Teresa of Calcutta: Let us thus praise You in the way You love best, by shining on those around us.

Let us preach You without preaching, not by words but by example.

by the catching force, the sympathetic influence of what we do, the evident fullness of the love our hearts bear for You (2)

Sing of the coming of the Lord: play, sing, whistle, hum the expectant and joyful music of the season - through daily tasks; in the car; in the garden; in sacred spaces. Pray. Smile.

Proclaim: Witness the humility of John, the last of the Old Testament prophets, baptising in readiness for Christ, but 'unfit to undo his sandal strap' (2)

Rejoice: that nothing can come between us and the love of God made visible in Jesus Christ.

Share your joy: Pope Francis sees a warm and joyful connection between holiness and good humour. He commends to us his Morning Prayer attributed to St Thomas More (3)
