### O precious and wonderful banquet

—On the feast of Corpus Christi

St Thomas Aquinas

*Below is the second reading from the Office of Readings for the solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, or Corpus Christi in Latin. The Author, St Thomas Aquinas, was one of the greatest theologians in the history of our Church. The following excerpt from the work of St Thomas Aquinas, is a very good reflection and very appropriate for us to read this weekend. Also, please keep in your prayers all those children who are receiving their First Holy Communion this weekend during 6pm on Saturday and 9am Mass on Sunday Masses. At the same time, we thank and pray for our Sacramental Team, coordinated by Stephanie Lenihan. They have been doing a great job and our parish is very blessed with them. Enjoy Reading.*

Fr Baiyi

Since it was the will of God's only-begotten Son that men should share in his divinity, he assumed our nature in order that by becoming man he might make men gods. Moreover, when he took our flesh he dedicated the whole of its substance to our salvation. He offered his body to God the Father on the altar of the cross as a sacrifice for our reconciliation. He shed his blood for our ransom and purification, so that we might be redeemed from our wretched state of bondage and cleansed from all sin. But to ensure that the memory of so great a gift would abide with us for ever, he left his body as food and his blood as drink for the faithful to consume in the form of bread and wine.

O precious and wonderful banquet, that brings us salvation and contains all sweetness! Could anything be of more intrinsic value? Under the old law it was the flesh of calves and goats that was offered, but here Christ himself, the true God, is set before us as our food. What could be more wonderful than this? No other sacrament has greater healing power; through it sins are purged away, virtues are increased, and the soul is enriched with an abundance of every spiritual gift. It is offered in the Church for the living and the dead, so that what was instituted for the salvation of all may be for the benefit of all. Yet, in the end, no one can fully express the sweetness of this sacrament, in which spiritual delight is tasted at its very source, and in which we renew the memory of that surpassing love for us which Christ revealed in his passion.

It was to impress the vastness of this love more firmly upon the hearts of the faithful that our Lord instituted this sacrament at the Last Supper. As he was on the point of leaving the world to go to the Father, after celebrating the Passover with his disciples, he left it as a perpetual memorial of his passion. It was the fulfilment of ancient figures and the greatest of all his miracles, while for those who were to experience the sorrow of his departure, it was destined to be a unique and abiding consolation.



## Faith Matters: The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ – Corpus Christi

*Is not the cup of thanksgiving for which we give thanks a participation in the blood of Christ? And is not the bread that we break a participation in the body of Christ? Because there is one loaf, we, who are many, are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf." (1 Corinthians 10:16-17)*

**We Recall:** The feast of Corpus Christi has been honoured since the 13th century. St Juliana, St Thomas Aquinas, Pope Urban IV and Pope Clement V are each credited with a role in the inauguration of the feast. Many Christian communities have celebrated the feast with processions of the faithful through towns and villages, and with outdoor Masses.

**Pope Francis:** 'Jesus gives himself to us in the Eucharist; shares in our journey, indeed he makes himself food, the true food that sustains our life also in moments when the road becomes hard-going and obstacles slow our steps. And in the Eucharist the Lord makes us walk on his road, that of service, of sharing, of giving; and if it is shared, that little we have, that little we are, becomes riches, for the power of God — which is the power of love — comes down into our poverty to transform it'.

**Called to be the Body of Christ in the World:** 'Let us bless and break bread together as a symbol of our unity in Christ. As often as we eat the bread and drink the cup that proclaim the Lord's death, let the love of Christ compel us to hand on to others, without judgement or measure, the blessings we ourselves have received so generously at your hand'.

You live in the heart of the Father in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen'.
