Jesus, The Good Shepherd

Some handicapped children were asked to make a drawing of their idea of God. One girl drew "an open door" because she always felt locked in; God was an open door to friendship. Another child painted "a foot" because he could not walk; he thought of God as joy, being able to walk and touch the grass with his toes. A third person sketched "a flower" for she believed that God is all beauty. Similarly, Christ gives himself the image of a "shepherd."

As our shepherd He knows each of us by name. We are precious to Him. Christ will not allow us to perish, come what may. People may sometimes give up on us, but never the Lord, for whether we live or die, we belong to him.

In the Gospel of John, Jesus tells us that we are His flock and that He is giving us eternal life, and no one will snatch us out of the Father's hand. He has promised all of us that we will have a high place in heaven. Jesus tells us just how much He yearns for each one of us. Sit with Jesus, the Good Shepherd, and hear Him call your name. Journey within and listen to His soothing voice telling you that you already belong to Jesus: "My sheep hear my voice. I know them and they follow me. I give them eternal life and they will never perish. No one will snatch them out of my hand."

We need to find our inner most place. There we will recognize the unique cadence and texture of God's way of speaking to us and calling us by name. The way into that place in our heart is through the door of our natural gifts. Listen to what our true friends say about us. Which gifts do they most often mention? These gifts express our essence, the "who" of us that cannot be taken away or lost.

The good news is that we belong to Jesus, the Good Shepherd. In him we will find our way home. All we must do is listening to the voice of God. There is no question that Jesus is the Good Shepherd. The only question that remains at this point is this: Do we know the Good Shepherd?

The good news is that we belong to Jesus, the Good Shepherd. In Him we will find our way home. All we have to do is listening to the voice of God. How we answer that question determines where we can expect to spend eternity. Our answer to that question will make all the difference between Heaven and Hell. If we know the Shepherd, then we can rejoice in the fact that He will ever be with us and that He will ever watch over us. If we do not know Him, then let us all to come to Him right now. We do not have to wait. Delay is dangerous. Come to Jesus today and He will save our souls. He will place us in the flock of God. He will save us and will give us a new life and a new birth. He is our good Shepherd who knows us and we are willing to die for the sheep.
