MISSION STATEMENT

"Saint Peter's Parish is a community who lives in faith of Jesus Christ and, moved by the Spirit, continues to grow in our love for God and all people."

The Ascension of the Lord (Year A) 21st May 2023

Readings: Acts 1:1-11 Ephesians 1:17-23 Matthew 28:16-20

Priority: Implementing Integral Ecology

Consider for a moment the following question: why does the Church exist? We might rephrase the question and ask, what is the Church's mission? On this Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord, the Gospel reading provides us with an answer. Before ascending into heaven, Jesus says, "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all the nations." What is the Church's mission? To make disciples of Jesus. Recent Popes have continued to remind us of this central mission. Pope Paul VI said that the Church "exists in order to evangelize" (EN 14), and Pope Francis wrote that "in all its activities the parish encourages and trains its members to be evangelizers" (EG 28). If the Church exists to make disciples, we must consider what is a disciple, and how do we make disciples? This is interconnected with the sixth apostolic priority: Implementing Integral Ecology.

Archbishop Mark writes: Natural and human ecology interact in mysterious and unmistakable ways. To interfere with one is to interfere with the other; to promote the good of one is to promote the good of the other. Fratelli Tutti focuses more upon human ecology in speaking of the radical interconnectedness of all human beings at a moment when alienation and polarisation are making disconnectedness seem the norm. The Church is called in such a moment to be a sign of contradiction, speaking in a way that rises above politics and economics so that a genuinely biblical and Christian voice can be heard.

What is a Disciple? The disciples had a personal relationship with Jesus. They didn't just know him, they also followed him, and allowed him to transform their lives. Do we have a personal relationship with Jesus? To be a disciple is to be filled with the Holy Spirit. This happens for each of us firstly in baptism, but then in confirmation, the sacrament which "perpetuates the grace of Pentecost" (Pope Paul VI) and empowers us for our mission. Beyond this, St Paul reminds us to, "be filled with the Spirit, as you sing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs" (Eph 5:18-19).

How do we make disciples? The Australian census data indicates that the fastest growing 'religion' in our Country is that cohort of people who identify as having 'no religion'. Given the decline of Christianity in the West, making disciples can be somewhat of a challenge!

What is the fruit of a disciple? The fruit of the disciple is more disciples. When Jesus called his disciples, he said he'd make them fishers of people. In the Gospel today he calls his disciples to go and do just that – to make disciples! Making disciples means walking in the empowerment of the Spirit received in confirmation to courageously share our faith, hope, and love with others.

Today our Lord calls each of us to go on mission but let us first consider our own journey as a disciple of Jesus. Are we walking in the grace of our baptism and the empowerment of the Spirit received in confirmation? Secondly let us consider the mission Jesus has given to us to make disciples of others. Finally, let us try for an ecological conversion that transforms hearts and minds toward a greater love of God, each other, and creation.

FAITH MATTERS:

Ascension Sunday: Why are we staring at the sky?

Luke tells us that after Jesus was lifted up while they looked on, the Apostles stood about amazed and bewildered staring at the sky. They were challenged by two angels who asked, "Why are you men from Galilee standing here looking into the sky?"

We might well ask ourselves the same question with even greater intensity. The Apostles were amazed, bewildered, and perhaps even scared at the events of the last 50 or so days. Their world had collapsed, Jesus had been crucified, resurrected, and now had disappeared into a cloud. Even though Jesus had given them instructions to remain in Jerusalem and to await a baptism of the Holy Spirit, they were perhaps caught up too much with their immediate sense of loss and fear of retribution from the Jewish authorities.

We don't have that excuse. We know the rest of the story, and even this Sunday we eagerly await the Feast of Pentecost next Sunday to celebrate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles.

We, like the Apostles have our instructions to go into the world, to make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Trinity and teaching them to observe Jesus' commands. We also have the power of the Holy Spirit to guide and encourage us to do just that, so let's stop staring at the sky, or the lovely interior of the cathedral or the candles or the decorations and get to work to take Christ to this broken world.
