# Weakness is our strength!

Hearty Festive Greetings to all as we celebrate our titular Feast. May St. Peter intercede for all of us.

The central theme of St. Peter's life is the encounter with Christ. He experienced a love that healed him and set him free. Peter, the fisherman from Galilee, was set free from his sense of inadequacy and his bitter experience of failure thanks to the unconditional love of Jesus. Although a skilled fisher, many times, he tasted the bitterness of frustration at having caught nothing and, seeing his empty nets, was tempted to pull up his oars. Even after saying that he was ready to give his life for Jesus, he denied the Master.

Jesus nonetheless loved Peter and was willing to take a risk on him. He encouraged Peter not to give up, to lower his nets once more, to walk on water, to find the strength to accept his own frailty, to follow him on the way of the cross, to give his life for his brothers and sisters, and to shepherd his flock. He gave him the courage. It was Peter whom Jesus called to strengthen his brothers in faith. He gave him the keys to an encounter with the Lord. Peter is important because he was the first Pope and kept the Church united while it was growing very rapidly after Pentecost. In the first years it was the Jewish people who accepted Jesus as the Saviour. So, Peter had very important tasks in the early Church.

It is a reminder to us that our talents and our weaknesses too can become God's means of helping others if we allow. We don't have to be perfect for God to work through us; God can work through us, as he did with Peter. It is this love that reminds us that with God all things are possible. St. Peter exemplifies to us that even if we are different and even if we have disagreements, we can still live and work together in the Church and we can find reconciliation one to another through God's grace and love, that is, if we are willing.

In the Gospel today the Lord asks Peter, who do you say that I am?" Peter answers Him, "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God." The Lord then responds to him, "Flesh and blood have not revealed this to you but rather my Father who is in Heaven." Jesus did not judge him or humiliate him. Instead, he shared his life with affection and closeness. He supported him by his prayer, and even at times reproached him to make him change. To Peter, Jesus gently says: "I have prayed for you that your own faith may not fail." (Lk 22:32).

St. Peter shows us that there is no easy Christian faith. Trials and temptations, the dark night of doubt, confusion, and uncertainty, are not just unfortunate accidents. "Simon, Simon, behold, Satan has desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat. But I have prayed for you, that your faith fail. Peter was God's role model for humanity, a luminary who was known to all. Why was someone so unremarkable raised up as an exemplar by God and extolled by successive generations?

# FAITH MATTERS: The Eucharist

Things Jesus did NOT say about the Eucharist

- This looks like my body.
- This represents my body
- This symbolises my body.

Flannery O'Connor was a devout Catholic and her faith was central to her life and work. In a letter she wrote in December of 1955, she recounted a dinner party where the topic of the Eucharist came up. She famously had this to say of the Eucharist: "Well, if it's a symbol, to hell with it." She also said that the Eucharist "is the center of existence for me; all the rest of life is expendable."

Things Jesus DID say about the Eucharist

-"While they were eating, He took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them, and said, 'Take it; this IS my body.' (*Mark 14:22*)

- "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him" (*John 6:56*).

- "Then He took the bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them, saying, 'This is my body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of me." (*Luke 22:19-20*).

"Jesus said to them, 'I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst." (*John 6:35*).

"I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world.' (*John 6:51*)
