Pentecost Sunday (Year A) 28th May 2023

Readings: Acts 2:1-11 1 Corinthians 12:3-7, 12-13 John 20:19-23

Pentecost: Birthday of the Church: Priority: Embedding Synodal Governance

Have you ever been in a situation where you're the only person who doesn't speak the language that everyone is talking? It's a strange feeling. You're in the same place, you're with other people, but you have no idea what is being said. You can't understand what is going on, and you can't contribute. Whether it was intentional or not, you are inevitably excluded. On this great celebration of Pentecost, we turn our attention to the birth of a truly inclusive Church.

Archbishop Mark writes: We have begun the long and complex process of moving towards a synodal mode of governance in the Church, but the process is far from complete; and there is much to be done to embed synodal governance more securely at every level in the Archdiocese... Synodality implies inclusion, and therefore we will have to keep asking how we might at every level include women in the decision-making processes of the Archdiocese. So too synodality requires transparency and accountability, and we will have to keep asking what we need to do to make the Archdiocese more transparent and accountable.

1. **An Inclusive Church is Born**: The Spirit of God was moving through the Apostles so that every tribe and nation could hear the Gospel and be included in Christ. Here we recognise something essential to the Christian tradition: the Church is inspired and empowered by the Holy Spirit, everyone is welcomed and invited, and the Gospel is to be preached in ways that everyone can understand.

In a recent general audience, Pope Francis said "If the Church does not pray to and invoke the Spirit, it closes in on itself, in sterile and exhausting debates, in wearisome polarisations, while the flame of mission is extinguished."

2. **An Inclusive Leadership for an Inclusive Church**: It follows that a truly inclusive Church must have truly inclusive leadership. In recent years, Pope Francis has been encouraging this with reference to the word "synodality." Synodality is the process of walking together in open dialogue and mutual respect with a path – deliberately journeying – not aimlessly wandering about. Pope Francis said that a "synodal Church is a Church which listens, which realizes that listening is more than simply hearing. It is a mutual listening in which everyone has something to learn. The faithful people, the college of bishops, the Bishop of Rome: all listening to each other, and all listening to the Holy Spirit, the Spirit of truth."

3. **A Church with One Body and Many Parts**: St Paul explains that every baptised person is "given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good." This means that everyone has something unique to offer the Church and the world. At Pentecost we are reminded that all of us are called to the mission of Christ to make disciples.

On this birthday of the Church, we are reminded that the Church is inspired and empowered by the Holy Spirit to be inclusive and to preach the Gospel in language that everyone can understand. This apostolic priority challenges us all to go on a journey toward becoming a Church where the faithful people, the college of bishops, the Bishop of Rome are all listening to each other, and all listening to the Holy Spirit, the "Spirit of truth." *Archbishop Mark Coleridge - (abridged by Fr Johny)*

FAITH MATTERS: Pentecost Power

Does it really only pertain to the beginnings of the Church, and is it even something that actually happened as described in the Book of the Acts of the Apostles?

What we can see in today's Gospel, is that Jesus "breathed on" those gathered in the upper room, and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit." Yet they didn't suddenly change from their fearfulness, jump up and start praising God in "tongues" for everyone to hear. No, it was days after Jesus' ascension that the Holy Spirit worked so spectacularly, and everything changed dramatically. Jesus had always operated in the power of the Spirit, so there were many dramatic events associated with his life and ministry on a day-to-day basis. Once the Spirit had empowered the disciples, they too became associated with constant miracles, which affirmed the Good News they were preaching, and helped draw new converts to The Way and into the fraternity of Love.

In my own life as a "cradle Catholic" I was sauntering along spiritually, going to Mass, the sacraments, and doing things like being a server and a reader: generally aiming to stay on the straight and narrow. It wasn't until my life circumstances turned particularly sour that I took a long, deep look at what Jesus is supposed to have done for me to make my life work blessedly. In doing so, I recognised the sureness and the depth of God's love: revealed in the humility, patience and selflessness Jesus displayed.

That eye-opening moment was a Pentecost for me, leading me to put my life consciously, deliberately, into God's hands, asking him to take my life wherever he desired while always granting me the grace to cooperate.

It's been a lengthy work in progress, but as I keep recommitting my heart to God, he brings me closer and closer to him in love: step by little step.
