Active ministry service in our parish

As we can clearly tell, COVID-19 has badly affected our Church life in many different ways since its outbreak. The number of Mass attendances has decreased; it is becoming more difficult to get enough ministers for all the different ministry groups; some parishioners or their family members are still suffering from the long COVID, and etc. For most of the parishes, the vitality of the parish life hasn't restored to the level before the start of the virus. Our parish is one of them but our situation is probably better than in some other parishes. I would like to share with you some pieces of exciting news about the recent activities in our parish.

On Friday evening, 26th of August, there were 31 children in our parish who received the sacrament of confirmation. Our church was packed with the children, their families and friends. This year, we could not have a bishop to celebrate the sacrament with us. Fr John Conway, parish priest of Regents Park and dean of the Logan deanery, was delegated and he presided over the liturgy in a very beautiful way. Fr John delivered a vivid homily and led the whole congregation in a very prayerful atmosphere during the liturgy.

As I talked about some months ago, two members of our parish pastoral council (PPC) have resigned because of their work and family commitments. In our parish, we have a new PPC every two years. We formed the current PPC last year and their tenure lasts until 2023. As a result of the resignations, we needed to appoint some new members to PPC. Thankfully, three parishioners generously accepted this role and have been appointed as the new PPC councillors. During Saturday 6pm Mass this weekend, they will be formally commissioned. For our parish, this is a wonderful piece of news.

For a Catholic parish, evangelisation is always the top priority. That is why we formed a new ministry group, named as Evangelisation Task Group (ETG), last year. Through the work of ETG, we hope we can share our faith with others and reach out to invite people in the wider community. In this way, we hope there will be those who would like to join our community in following Jesus Christ and walking together with us on the journey towards the kingdom of heaven. After expressing their willingness to join us, our RCIA team accompanies them and walks with them on their journey of faith. During the 9am Mass this weekend, a lady, Kelly Chew, will take a very significant step on her journey of faith, becoming a formal elect for the sacraments of Christian initiation. Then, on Sunday 9th October at 9am Mass, Kelly's initiation will be celebrated with Bishop Tim, who will be paying our parish a formal episcopal visit on that weekend.

Dear friends, our parish is still very active in spite of the negative influence of COVID-19. Let us thank our Lord for this. However, like many other parishes, we are facing challenges and difficulties, too. Many, if not all, of our parish ministry groups are struggling with the number of members, however the groups are active and they serve our parish well. For example, three members of our sacramental team have resigned. There are only three active members for RCIA team. It was difficult to get enough members for PPC last year and to find the new members this year. It would be much better if we can have more people on ETG. **Therefore, we would like to encourage more parishioners to come forward and join in our different ministry groups. Your gifts will be very welcome. Then we can possibly keep the vitality of our parish.**
