## International Day of Prayer, Reflection and Action against Human Trafficking

In 2015 Pope Francis initiated the International Day to draw our attention to the brutal crime of Human Trafficking. Millions of people worldwide are robbed of their freedom and their dignity which is their birthright as human beings, The Theme this year is "Journeying in dignity." The Day is observed on 8th February and coincides with the feast day of St.Josephine Bakhita. She is the patron Saint of all those who are trafficked and enslaved. St.Josephine was kidnapped as a child in Sudan by Arab slavers. She was sold and resold many times and endured inhuman treatment. After regaining her freedom, she joined the Canossian Sisters, forgave her tormentors and served God through prayer and service to the local community. Pope St.John Paul II canonised her on 1st October, 2000.

Human Trafficking is an extremely profitable business. Traffickers will target anyone to make money illegally. Although it is difficult to determine the full scale of this crime, estimates indicate that the \$150 billion industry profits from about 40.3 million victims worldwide. Traffickers target anyone, men, women and children of any age and in any condition. There is labour and sexual exploitation, child labour, forced marriage and organ trafficking.

Many people depend on us for their freedom. In our own country Anti-Slavery Australia are leaders committed to the abolition of slavery through research, policy development, law reform, professional practice, education and advocacy. Their work is sustained by many volunteers and key supporters and fundraisers. In the past 20 years, this organisation's impact has been substantial, with advocacy, legal and practical help for hundreds of vulnerable people. It has made appeals to Commonwealth, States and foreign governments. Anti Slavery Australia's recommendations have been adopted as legislation for Australia's Modern Slavery Act. This organisation has also created awareness training for community workers, law enforcement and airline crews and elearning courses on modern slavery. One of the key supporters of Anti-Slavery Australia is ACRATH(Australian Catholic Religious Against Trafficking in Humans.) However, ACRATH is also a member of a much larger organisation called Talitha Kum. This is a network of more than 2 000 catholic religious sisters who live in 92 countries. These sisters serve on the frontlines of the anti-slavery movement, particularly in the fight against sexual trafficking. They aim to prevent, protect and rehabilitate victims. The name Talitha Kum comes from Aramaic and means: "Little girl, I say to you, rise". These are the words Jesus spoke when he raised the daughter of Naim from death to life (Mark 5:41). In 2021 the work of Talitha Kum benefitted 258 549 individuals (Talitha Kum Report,21st June,2022) granting them a new, dignified life. According to Pope Francis human trafficking has created an open wound on the body of Christ and the body of all humanity. The Pope implores us to pray for an economy of care and to eliminate all forms of inequalities as there is simply no place for slavery in the 21 century. Please take the papal advice to heart and pray for a world where all human beings enjoy a free, dignified life.

**Catholic Foundations module 1: Catholic Theology in Context** 

At the heart of the new Archdiocesan Centre for Catholic Formation's offerings are the four core modules entitled Catholic Foundations. Catholic Foundations is designed to draw Catholics into the fullness of the Catholic life and provide formation for those considering ministry roles. The experience will engage both the head and the heart, so participants grow in knowledge and the lived experience of Catholic faith. Each module includes 10 sessions supported with individual reflection and a certificate awarded for completion. The modules will be spread across four semesters in 2023 and 2024.
