### Wonderful memories of 37 years in St. Peter's community, Rochedale

Frank and I moved to Rochedale South 37 years ago and made our way to St Peter's Church for Mass. We were warmly welcomed and soon found ourselves at home in the Parish. One of the first roles we were invited to join was to help with the youth group. We were a young married couple and thought to be suited to this ministry. We joined the leaders-Peter, Dawn and others- enjoying many activities; taking the youth to bowling, the local water theme parks, making many sausage sizzles and even supervising some disco dances in the Parish Centre, before it was renovated. We had Youth Masses and prayer reflection evenings to support the members spiritually.

One of the main activities the youth did to support the local community was to doorknock in the annual Cancer Foundation appeal to raise money for cancer research. The young people would gather in small groups, spend the morning with their maps and donation receipts and bags and would bring the money they raised to the parish office, which was the demountable in those days. We would finish with some sandwiches and fruit before I took the money to the city to the Cancer Foundation office. The generosity of these young people was outstanding, giving of their time and energy to help others. Parishioners could see the work of the youth as they answered the door to them! The youth participated for many years in this endeavour until the method of fundraising changed.

Fr Morgan Batt was a seminarian during this time and often helped out with the youth activities as well, in the year he spent learning in the Parish. He also drew the ink sketch of St Peter's Church that featured on many parish publications of the time and is still well recognised.

A great highlight of working with the youth of the Parish was World Youth Day 2008 in Sydney. The parishioners assisted in fundraising and the youth assisted at many a bake sale and other raffles to fund the journey with as little personal cost as possible. We had a busload of people and made our way to Sydney by coach. Amazing parishioners came along to guide the youth and care for them. Helen and Michael were the cooks and did a wonderful job at this so that we were always fed and energised. Kevin and John made sure we were never lost and kept up to date with all that was happening on the trains and at the events. We prayed in many ways each day and encountered Catholic youth from all over the world. It was exciting to see Pope Benedict close up and we walked over the Harbour Bridge to spend a freezing night at the racetrack in order to participate in the closing Mass. It was all worth it and our faith grew as a result. Even waiting in the cold during a false fire alarm at our accommodation turned out to be an opportunity to look after each other and grow in our friendships. God was with us on the journey. After this event the youth continued to participate in Youth Mass and social outings. We were grateful for the amazing support of all the Parish.

In the history of St Peter's, youth have always been special members of our Parish community and still are!

Each year on 2nd November, the Feast of Holy Souls, our parish celebrates a special Memorial Mass. While this Mass is intended for all members of the parish, it offers recently bereaved families a particular time for their own prayer and reflection. A candle ceremony creates a reverent moment for remembering those loved ones who have died in the past year. A named candle for each loved one can be taken home as a symbol of remembrance. Across many years, Bereavement Group members have been convinced that this special Mass is greatly valued, since it is always very well and warmly attended. Some families use the Mass as a 'family reunion' occasion. Some families have brought neighbours and friends who are in need of time to pause peacefully and remember. The Bereavement Ministry is not a weighty responsibility. Meetings are rare. You are most welcome to join us!

### FAITH MATTERS:

#### BLESSED CARLOS ACUTIS - October 7th/8th

One of the more interesting people on the path to beatification as a saint is Blessed Carlo Acutis, a Catholic Italian teenager who was beatified Oct. 10, 2020, in Assisi. Carlo Acutis was born May 3, 1991, in London. Just a few months later, his parents, Andrea Acutis and Antonia Salzano, moved to Milan. As a teenager, Carlo was diagnosed with leukemia. He died on Oct. 12, 2006, and was buried in Assisi because of his love for St. Francis of Assisi. His cause for canonization began in 2013. He was designated "Venerable" in 2018 and was designated "Blessed" October 10, 2020.

From a young age, Carlo seemed to have a special love for God, even though his parents weren't especially devout. After he made his First Communion, he went to Mass as often as he could. He asked his parents to take him on pilgrimages to the places of the saints, and to the sites of Eucharistic miracles.

His witness of faith led to a deep conversion in his mom, because, according to the priest promoting his cause for sainthood, he "managed to drag his relatives, his parents to Mass every day.

He was known for defending kids at school who got picked on, especially disabled kids. Carlos built a website cataloguing and promoting Eucharistic miracles. On the site, he told people that "the more often we receive the Eucharist, the more we will become like Jesus, so that on this earth we will have a foretaste of heaven."
