

Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord (Year A)

9th April 2023

Readings: **Vigil Mass:** Genesis 1:1-2 2 or 1:1,26-31 Genesis 22:1-18

Matthew 28:1-10

Sunday Mass: Acts 10:34,37-43 Colossians 3:1-4 John 20:1-9

Jesus is Risen (Hallelujah/Praise)

Happy Easter. May the Risen Lord bless us.

My faith in the resurrection of Christ rests on two pieces of solid evidence: first, an empty tomb and second the testimony of Jesus' followers who had nothing to gain from proclaiming Jesus' resurrection except their own martyrdom. They would never have had the courage to preach about Jesus if Jesus hadn't risen and appeared to them. Our belief too, as St. Paul tells us, is not only that Jesus rose from the dead to live in eternal glory, but it is a glory we hope to share with him some day. No matter how powerful and final is the force of death, because of Jesus' resurrection, we believe that life has the final word not death and it is the life eternal.

In one of his lighter moments Benjamin Franklin penned his own epitaph. Influenced by St. Paul's teaching of the resurrection of the body here is what he wrote: "The Body of Benjamin Franklin, Printer, like the cover of an old book, its contents torn out, and script of its lettering and gilding, lies here, food for worms, but the work shall not be wholly lost: for it will, as he believed, appear once more in a new and more perfect edition, corrected and amended by its Author." So, our belief in Christ's resurrection is our hope that one day we too will join him to share the glory of eternal life.

The poet Laureate Maya Angelou captures this sense in her poem: "Out of the huts of history's shame I Rise, up from a past that is rooted in pain I Rise, leaving behind nights of terror and fear I Rise, into a daybreak that tis wondrously clear I Rise, bringing the gifts that my ancestors gave, I am the dream and the hope of the slave. I Rise I Rise I Rise."

Easter proves that God is in control. He may be silent, but he is not still. He moved out of the tomb and is moving amidst us. He is here with us and will be with us all the time. Watch on, lest we miss Him who comes in forms and shapes we know not.

Archbishop Desmond Tutu says, "Easter says to us that despite everything to the contrary, His will for us will prevail, love will prevail over hate, justice over injustice and oppression, peace over exploitation and bitterness."

What do the words "Peace be with you" say to us? They say that no matter how many times we sin, no matter how grievous our offenses are, God stands ready to forgive us and release us from guilt. He does this so that we can experience the peace that comes from being reconciled with him. As long as we stay with him, his peace will stay with us.

The peace that Jesus brings helps us face troubling circumstances without becoming swallowed up by anxiety or anger or fear. It brings a quiet confidence to our hearts that guides us as we face challenging decisions. It's a peace that depends not on the events of our day but on the boundless love of the Lord: "I belong to Christ, and I know that he will never abandon me!"
