## Something to Think About

What does love 'look' like? What does love 'feel' like? What does love 'sound' like?

## **The Story**

Jesus tells his disciples that, if they love him, they will do what he asks of them. What does Jesus ask of them, and of us? Jesus asks us to love others, forgive others, be helpful, respect others. Jesus tells them they don't have to do this alone. The Holy Spirit will always be with us as a helper. These words are a great comfort, for they assure us that God is always with us.

### A reading from the holy gospel according to John

14:15-21

Jesus said to his disciples:

"If you love me, you will do as I command. Then I will ask the Father to send you the Holy Spirit who will help you and always be with you. The Spirit will show you what is true.

The people of this world cannot accept the Spirit, because they don't see or know him.

But you know the Spirit, who is with you and will keep on living in you.

I won't leave you like orphans. I will come back to you.

In a little while the people of this world won't be able to see me, but you will see me.

And because I live, you will live.

Then you will know that I am one with the Father.

You will know that you are one with me, and I am one with you.

"If you love me, you will do what I have said, and my Father will love you. I will also love you and show you what I am like."

# **Group Activity**


### **Love in Action – Helping Hearts Wreath**
