Readings: Acts 2:1-11

Romans 8:8-18

John 14:15-16, 23-26

Rely on the Holy Spirit

Jesus said to His disciples: "Peace be with you." when He was sending them out for mission. Then what could guarantee the peace Jesus was promising? Jesus gave them the answer immediately: The Holy Spirit. Only with the Holy Spirit, can a person possibly have inner peace. Only with the Holy Spirit, can this 'sending out for mission' bear plenty of fruits. That is why, in the Acts of the Apostles, the work of the Holy Spirit is throughout the whole book. That is why the Acts of the Apostles is called the gospel of the Holy Spirit. That is why Pentecost is called the birthday of the Church.

Nowadays, for many Catholics, there are many concerns about our Church. Those concerns might make many of us feel nervous and unsettled. So, we do need to have the peace of Jesus. Similarly, such peace can only be guaranteed by the Holy Spirit. Now let us reflect on one really big concern that is shared by many of us. This big concern is that, in today's society, many young people don't go to church regularly anymore. There must be many factors that contribute to this situation. Whatever the reasons are, it's very urgent for us to do something about it. In our parish, we have already started taking concrete actions. Below are two examples.

In early April, thank God, we blessedly met our youth ministry Coordinator, Olivia Brown. Out of the hard work by Olivia and her team, last Saturday after 6pm Mass, we successfully held our youth event launch. From now on, our parish will be running three youth groups, one for year 4 to 6 students, another one for year 7 to 12, the third one for those aged 18 to 35. If your age is suitable for any of these groups, please join the group and build it up. For other parishioners, please try to support our youth ministry through prayer, donation, service and in whatever other ways are possible for you.

This weekend, we are celebrating our Family School Mass. Actually, we celebrate this Mass quite regularly. By doing this, we hope our parents, students and teachers can realize one important thing. Our children can benefit greatly from attending Mass and other church activities. It can give them a chance to follow the Holy Spirit and to learn from Jesus systematically. Attending Mass and other church activities can offer our children a place which becomes a lifelong learning opportunity—a place for teaching, learning and being reminded and encouraged to be better people in God's love. It also can extend to them a chance to make lifelong friends, since the parish community is always here and our students are usually from this area. Hopefully, this will work for us to encourage more young people to practice their faith.

My dear friends, although we have been doing many things, one thing is more important than anything else. That is: we should turn to the Holy Spirit first and always follow Him. All of us should do what we can, then we leave the rest to the Holy Spirit. Only in and with the Holy Spirit, can our work bear fruits. With this in mind, if we try our best, our youth ministry, and all the ministries in our parish, will bear fruits. Whatever the immediate results will be, we will have Jesus' peace in our hearts, to continue Jesus' work through the Holy Spirit.
