## Did You Know? Prayer of the Faithful

Some of you may have noticed, we have made a hardly detectable change. In the PowerPoint of our weekend Masses, we changed "Prayers of the Faithful" to "Prayer of the Faithful". This official name gives us a profound insight into its nature—the prayer of the faithful, the baptised, and a universal prayer for all people in need, joining our prayers to those of Christ, praying with and through Him.

Below is a short article prepared by our Liturgy Ministry Team. It explains more about this prayer, to whom we address it, the correct structure of the prayer, and the importance of the pause between the prayers and the cue. Also, it's crucial to note that this prayer should be universal as well as local, reflecting parish issues as well as those affecting the whole world. I would like to take this opportunity to thank our Liturgy Ministry Team coordinated by Elizabeth Fort and invite all of you to read this article.

You may have already been wondering about the title Prayer of the Faithful. Shouldn't it be Prayers?

There are a lot of ideas about Prayer of the Faithful so the Liturgy Ministry team would like to share some information with you to help you pray these authentically.

There seems to be a misunderstanding about Prayer of the Faithful (and it is Prayer, not Prayers). In this prayer, the reader does not address God at all, but rather announces intentions to the people.

Fr Baiyi begins the Intercessions of the Mass by speaking to those present and inviting them to pray. At St Peter's, the intentions are then announced by a reader, using a form of words such as "Let us pray for/ that...".

importantly, we all pray about the announced intentions in the pause that follows each one. After a time of silence comes the cue (eg "Lord, hear us") and the community responds together (eg "Lord, hear our prayer").

If there is no silence, then there is no prayer - just a list of statements. The petitions only become the "Prayer of the Faithful" when the people respond to the invitation, formulate their own prayer in their hearts and bring their prayers together in the "Lord, hear our prayer".

The prayers must be relevant to the special needs and concerns that people are facing at a particular time, as well as stretching our compassion to include the whole world.

We hope that you enjoy praying the Prayer of the Faithful each week.
