(Year A Readings: Acts 8:5-8, 14-17 1 Peter 3:15-18 John 14:15-21)

If you love me, you will keep my commandments

There are always some special people in our lives. They are our loved ones and we try our best to love them. For example, we buy our children new clothes, dressing them up like princes or princesses; or cook for them, and watch them eating happily. We visit our elderly parents, walking and chatting with them, making their latter years contented. We try to be always there for our friends. When they are in need, they've got some people to rely on; when they are sorrowful, they have some people to talk to. Also, we make some special romantic times for our other halves, buying them flowers or other gifts, making them feel happy. In summary, in our world, when we love somebody, we always try to do or sacrifice something for them. In this way, the one whom we love will have a better and happier life.

We know that Jesus has loved us to death. Not only that, He has been with us always, especially under the sacramental form. His love for us has never stopped. Because of that, we are happy to follow Him, trying to love Him back. Then, how should we love Him?

In today's Gospel, Jesus has already told us that, saying, "If you love me, you will keep my commandments". Then what are His commandments? In His conversation with a scribe, Jesus condensed all the Laws and Prophets as "love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul and with all your mind" and "love your neighbour as yourself" (cf. Matt 22:34-40). So, "love God and neighbour" has become His commandments. Apart from this, He has also given us a new commandment: "Love one another as I have loved you" (John 15:12). In one word, Jesus' commandment is "to love": our love for Jesus is carried out and completed by loving one another.

Therefore, the way that we love Jesus is different from the way that we love people. When we love people, we do or sacrifice something for them, but when we love Jesus, we do or sacrifice something for ourselves. In this world, the way we love is to make those who are loved by us have a better and happier life. However, the way we love Jesus is to make those who love, namely, ourselves, have a better and fuller life. Why is this? Because Jesus is God and God is already perfect. God can't be better or fuller. The reason that He requires us to love Him is to make our lives better and fuller.

Dear friends, please know that we don't need to do anything FOR God. For example, it's not that we do sacrifices FOR God. We don't need to accompany God for a whole night, or travel a long distance to visit Him. God doesn't need any of that at all. WE DO ALL OF THAT FOR OUR OWN SPIRITUAL GROWTH AND MATURITY. What we need to do is that, in His name and by following His example, we love one another, serve one another, and bear one another. Through this, the love in our hearts will get stronger and deeper. Then we will get closer and closer to Him and our human nature will get fuller and fuller. If we make this circle happen over and over again, we will eventually meet our God face-to-face and be with Him eternally, completing the last step of the unity of God and human.

During Australia's early days as a colony, with no priests, the rosary and devotion to Mary were significant for Catholics to nourish and maintain their faith. The title Mary Help of Christians has a long history, much of it relating to prayers for the defence of the Church in against non-Christians. Today, there are many Christians still suffering for their faith in non-Christian countries. Let us pray to Mary Help of Christians to intercede for our brothers and sisters in faith. Her Feast Day is 24th May.

Sacramental Program: This weekend 20th & 21st May the children have the second workshops to prepare for their First Holy Communion on the weekend of 3rd & 4th June. Please continue to pray for the children and their families.
