A big time for our RCIA candidates

Two weeks ago, our RCIA candidates received the sacrament of reconciliation for the first time at St Teresa Spirituality Centre, Ormiston. I wrote in my last weekend's newsletter reflection on the special gathering held on Saturday 7th December. It was a big step on their journey of RCIA. Our three candidates experienced God's mercy and forgiveness through the sacrament of reconciliation. As we know, they have each been baptized within another Christian tradition. To be fully received into our Catholic Church, they will need to receive the other two sacraments of initiation: Confirmation and Eucharist.

About Confirmation, the Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us that "the reception of the sacrament of Confirmation is necessary for the completion of the baptismal grace. For 'by the sacrament of Confirmation, the baptized are more perfectly bound to the Church and are enriched with a special strength of the Holy Spirit. Hence, they are, as true witnesses of Christ, more strictly obliged to spread and defend the faith by word and deed." (CCC 1285). By the celebration of Confirmation, the baptized receive "the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of right judgement and courage, the spirit of knowledge and reverence and the spirit of holy fear in God's presence." (CCC 1303). Of course, there is no limit to these gifts or fruits. As this sacrament is very important and valuable, our candidates have been preparing themselves for it, really carefully and well, for a long time.

Certainly, Eucharist is another very important and sacred sacrament. There is much more to the Eucharist than simply seeing it as the completion of the process of initiation. The Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life", a sacrament of love, a sign of unity, a bond of charity and a Paschal banquet. By celebrating of this sacrament, we welcome our Lord into our hearts under the form of bread and wine. We give thanks to God. We experience God's love and express our love for God. We remember Jesus' sacrifice on the cross for us. Hopefully, we build a community, the kingdom of heaven among us on earth. In one word, we grow much closer to God. Our candidates have already been celebrating Mass with us for a period of time, however, they have not received Holy Communion yet. With a period of time for preparation for this big moment, they have made them themselves ready to receive this sacrament.

My dear friends, this Sunday during the 9am Mass, all of three candidates, Harrison Porter, Deborah Meggs and Jessica Smith, are receiving these two sacraments of initiation. It is a big time for Harrison, Deb and Jess themselves, as well as an important moment for our whole parish community. We are very happy to see our community grow with new members. We are very blessed with them as our new fellow parishioners. Let us thank God for them. Also, let us congratulate them, pray for them and support them at all times.

<u>Faith Matters!</u> Fourth Sunday of Advent How might we make time and space for God in these last days of Advent?

Advent is a time for noticing our God who 'comes' to us in everyday life and our God who 'waits' patiently to welcome us, nurture us and hold us close to his heart. God is with us!

During Advent, we are invited to commit to times of silence and stillness and to notice God in our everyday experiences.

Practical suggestions that might help us become more aware of God's presence include: going for a slow, mindful walk; lighting the Advent candle/s at the family table; spending time with someone who is alone; gardening; listening to relaxing music; journaling or sketching; soaking in the beauty of creation e.g. gazing upon the sky, the clouds, the trees, the ocean, the sunrise or sunset.

Perhaps this time of slowing down in the midst of the last days of the Christmas rush is a reminder for us to discover more of what Julian of Norwich said: "The fullness of JOY is to behold God in everything!"

May we welcome our Everyday God into this time so that our preparations are joy-filled. Amen.

St Stephen: Have you ever wondered about St Stephen, whose Feast day we remember every year on 26th December and after whom our Cathedral is named? St Stephen was the first Martyr. He died in Jerusalem about the year 35AD. The feast of Stephen has been celebrated on this day since the fourth century. A Greek-speaking Jew, one of seven appointed by the apostles for special service (diakonia). Died confessing Christ and seeking divine mercy for those who were stoning him. Named in the Roman Canon (Eucharistic Prayer I). Remembered for preaching with wisdom and the Spirit (Acts 6:10), as one "full of grace and power" who "did great wonders and signs among the people" (Acts 6:8).
